### **SHOW RULES**

#### **\$30 FACILITY USE FEE FOR ALL NON-SHOWING HORSES**

Each class offered, will be covered by the rules and regulations of the current USEF, VHSA, and BHSA, rule books and will be conducted and judged accordingly. The judge's decision is final.

- **A.S.T.M. / S.E.I.** approved helmets with harnesses secured must be worn at all times when mounted
  - Proper attire and equipment is expected. No black stirrups allowed in equitation
  - Exhibitors ride at their own risk: Pursuant VA Code Annotated Title 3.2-6200-6203
  - All ages are as of December 1, 2017
  - KFEC points for year-end awards will be calculated as 1<sup>st</sup>- 10 pts, 2<sup>nd</sup> – 6pts, 3<sup>rd</sup> – 4pts, 4<sup>th</sup> – 2pts, 5<sup>th</sup> – 1 pt, 6<sup>th</sup>: .5pt, Champion – 10pts and Reserve Champion – 6pts
  - The Show Officials and Equestrian Center Staff reserve the right to refuse any entry, to change, combine, cancel, split classes or change officials
  - Kelly's Ford Equestrian Center, its employees and volunteers are not responsible for any accident or loss which may occur on the show grounds
  - All dogs must be kept on leashes or left at home **No exceptions.**

**\*\*\*\*\*The state of Virginia Requires the show possesses A COPY OF CURRENT NEGATIVE COGGINS FROM EVERY HORSE ON SHOW GROUNDS. YOU MUST submit a legible copy for each entry at EVERY SHOW before numbers will be issued.**

#### **Jumper Specifications:**

- Puddle Jumper:** Open to horses and ponies. Horses, ponies and riders in this Division may only cross enter into any class not exceeding 3' if otherwise eligible.
  - Novice Horse Jumper:** Open to horses and ponies in their 1 or 2 year of showing in jumper classes at 2'6" or higher as of December 1 of the current show year. Horses and ponies in this division may only cross enter into Novice Children's/Adult -Amateur Jumper if the rider is eligible, Low Jumper, and Puddle Jumper at the same show.
  - Novice Rider (Ch/Ad Amateur) Jumper:** Open to children and adult amateurs in their 1 or 2 year of showing in jumper classes at 2'6" or higher as of December 1 of the current show year. Riders in this division may only cross enter into Novice Jumper, if eligible, Low Jumper, and Puddle Jumper at the same show.
  - Low Jumper:** Open to horses and ponies. No restrictions on riders. (Exceptions: see Puddle Jumper, Novice Jumper and Novice Children's/Adult Amateur Jumper).
  - Children's/Adult Amateur Jumper:** Open to horses and ponies ridden by Children and Adult Amateurs.
- No cross-entering with the Novice Children's/Adult Amateur Jumper.
- Schooling Jumper:** Open to horses and ponies. No restrictions on riders.
  - Modified Jumper:** Open to horses and ponies. No restrictions on riders.
  - TB Jumper:** Open to Thoroughbreds registered with the Jockey Club or eligible to be registered.

#### **JP143 Table II– Classes scored on Faults and Time Timed 1st Round (Sec. 1)**

*The first round is decided by adding together the faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the Time Allowed. Horses with clean rounds or equal faults are classified according to their time taken to complete the course.*

##### **Power & Speed (Sec 2) (c)**

*The first phase to consist of 8 to 10 jumping efforts and the second phase (immediate jump-off) of 5 to 7 jumping efforts. Scores are decided by adding together the faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the Time Allowed if any. If a competitor has gone clean in the first round, he will, upon crossing the finish line, commence the designated jump-off course. Time starts as the horse crosses the finish line for the initial course. If there are no clean rounds and a tie exists for first place, there will be one jump-off, in which time will decide in the event of equality of faults. The use of a Time Allowed is optional in the first round. The Time Allowed in the first round may be taken by electronic or manual means.*

##### **JP146 TABLE IV– Optimum Time Classes:**

*In the case of equality of faults, ties will be broken on the following basis: an "Optimum Time" (defined as 4 seconds less than the Time Allowed for the course) will be posted on the course plan; the horse with the time on course closest to this Optimum Time (over or under) will prevail in the time, next closest next, etc.*

##### **Timed Jump-Off (Sec 2) (b)**

*The first round and first jump-off, if any, are decided by adding together the faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the Time Allowed. If a competitor has gone clean in the first round, the competitor will, without leaving the ring, upon an audible signal, commence the designated jump-off course.*

## Hunter Specifications

**-Leadline.** Open to children 7 years and younger as of 12/1/16. Only the class which is judged 50% and 50% suitability will count for BHSA points. Riders not allowed to cross enter into any classes where they would be asked to trot. Points go the rider.

**-Pre-Short Stirrup Equitation.** Open to riders 10 years and under as of 12/1/16. Riders may be asked to walk, trot, and perform simple Equitation tasks. Riders not allowed to cross enter into classes where they would be asked to canter or jump.

**-Short-Stirrup Equitation.** Open to riders 12 years and under as of 12/1/16. Jumps may not exceed 18". Riders not allowed to cross enter into classes where they would jump over 18". Courses may be trotted.

**-Student Equitation.** Open to riders in their first or second year of showing over fences at 2' or higher as of 12/1/16. Jumps to be a minimum of 2'. Riders competing in the Student Equitation Division are limited to two years only, whether they compete over fences or not. Courses may be trotted.

**-Short Stirrup Hunter.** Open to horses and ponies ridden by children 12 years and under. As of 12/1/16. Riders, ponies and horses may not cross enter into any other VHSA Associate Division or a VHSA Associate rated Equitation Class with the exception of VHSA Associate Junior Equitation on the Flat and Pleasure

**-Limit Rider Hunter:** Open to horses and ponies ridden by juniors and Adult Amateurs who are not entered in any classes jumping 2'6" or higher. These riders are not eligible for AA Equitation, Pony Equitation, or Jr./Children's Equitation. Ponies must be ridden by juniors. Horses and ponies may cross enter into other divisions. Courses to be a minimum of 6 fences set at 2'3". Pony or Pleasure Horse at any show in which they exhibit in the Short Stirrup Division.

**-Hunter Pleasure Pony.** Open to ponies shown with hunter tack ridden by a junior

**-VHSA/BHSA Pony Equitation.** Open to juniors mounted on ponies. A rider can only participate in one Associate Equitation Class per show, with the exception of the VHSA Equitation on the Flat Class. The heights for this class shall be no lower than small 2', med 2'3", and large 2'6".

**-Pony Hunter.** Open to ponies ridden by juniors. The height for this division shall be no lower than Small 2', Medium 2'3", Large 2'6".

**-Green Pony Hunter.** Open to ponies in 1<sup>st</sup> year showing O/F @ or above 2' for S, 2'3" for M, 2'6" for L, ridden by Juniors.

**-Pleasure Horse.** Open to horses ridden by an Adult. Horses may not cross enter into another VHSA Associate Pleasure Division at same show.

**-Junior Equitation on the Flat 14 & Under.** Open to riders who have not reached their 15 birthday by 12/1/16. Tests 1-19 may be used, excluding those requiring work over fences.

**-Junior Equitation on the Flat 15-17.** Open to riders who have reached their 15 birthday by 12/1/16, but not reached their 18 birthday as of December 1 of the calendar year. Tests 1-19 may be used, excluding those requiring work over fence

**-Adult Amateur Equitation on the Flat.** Open to amateurs 18 years of age and older. Tests 1-19 may be used, excluding those requiring work over fences.

**-Maiden Hunter.** Open to horses and ponies in their first year of showing over fences at 2' or higher as of 12/1/16. No restrictions on riders. Courses may be trotted.

**-Low Hunter.** Open to horses and ponies. No restrictions on riders. Jump height for Lows to be a minimum of 2' and not to exceed 2'3". May be combined with the Schooling Hunter if either or both do not have 3 entries. If combined, entries must jump the correct height for their Division

**-Green Hunter.** Open to horses in their 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> year of showing O/F @ 2'6" or higher.

**-Schooling Hunter.** 2'6" or 2'9" Open to horses and ponies. No restrictions on riders. Adults may ride ponies not entered in a Pony Division. May be combined with the Low Hunter if either or both do not have 3 entries. If combined, entries must jump the correct height for their Division.

**-Children's/Adult Amateur Hunter.** 2'6" or 3' open to horses ridden by Juniors or Adult Amateurs. The VHSA will not accept any points for any Riders on ponies.

**-VHSA/BHSA Children's/Adult Amateur Equitation.** Open to juniors and Adult Amateurs mounted on horses. A rider can only participate in one Associate Equitation Class per show, with the exception of the VHSA Equitation on the Flat Class.

**-Working Hunter.** 3' open to animals that are not entered in a pony division at the same show.

**-VHSA Pony Equitation Medal Class** - Open to Regular Junior Members of the VHSA who have not reached their 18th birthday. To be ridden on ponies, heights: 2'3" for ponies not exceeding 12.2 hands, 2'6" for ponies 12.2 hands to 13.2 hands, and ponies over 13.2 hands to 14.2 hands jump 3'.

**-VHSA Children's Medal Class** - Open to Regular Junior members of VHSA who have not reached their 18th birthday and who have not jumped higher than three feet at a show where entered in the Children's Hunter Division, except in Equitation. Open to horses only. Height at 3'.

**-VHSA Adult Amateur Medal Class** - Open to horses only. Contestant must hold a current amateur card issued by USEF. Height at 3'.
