RULES

- 1.** Entry fees: \$20 per class; \$55 per three-class division.
- 2.** No martingales are allowed in under saddle classes except for classes in Ring A.
- 3.** Scratches and adds must be made at the Horse Show Office prior to the start of a division.
- 4.** Meadowbrook Foundation Inc., d/b/a Meadowbrook Stables, MHSA, VHSA, and HCHSA, and their directors and employees, will not be responsible in any way for loss or damage to any person, animal, property or equipment. Each exhibitor shall assume all liability and hold harmless Meadowbrook Foundation Inc, MHSA, VHSA, and HCHSA for any loss, damage or injury to any person, animal, property or equipment that may be caused by any horse or pony entered by them or due to the carelessness or negligence of the person or persons in charge of such horse or pony or any of their subordinates or superiors.
- 5.** When mounted, all exhibitors must appear in proper attire with ASTM/SEI approved headgear with chinstrap fastened. No one will be allowed in the ring during judging unless on official business.
- 6.** Judges' decisions are final in all events.
- 7.** All exhibitors shall have the responsibility for prompt and timely appearance at class time. Any announced one - minute calls will be enforced.
- 8.** Management reserves the right to decline any entry and to return any entry fee before or during the show without being liable for compensation. Should any question or dispute arise that is not provided for in the rules, the same shall be referred to management, whose decision shall be final.
- 9.** All prize money will be paid through the show office. Please allow 45 minutes after completion of class for prize money to be credited. All prize money in excess of balances due will be mailed to the owner of record, unless otherwise directed, within 30 days after completion of the show.
- 10.** Controlled schooling is allowed in the hunter rings from 6:30 until 8:00 a.m. No longing is allowed in the rings or schooling area. Poling is not allowed.
- 11.** Dogs are *not* allowed on the show grounds. Dog owners are subject to a \$50 fine for dogs on show grounds.
- 12.** Classes offered are those listed in the time schedule. Courses will be posted at the respective in-gate one hour before each class, unless specifications state otherwise.
- 13.** All vehicles must park in designated areas. NO CAR PARKING in designated trailer areas.

CLASS 71: GAMBLER'S CHOICE CHARITY JUMPER CLASS

Have Fun And Support KIPP Student Riders!


Proceeds from this class will support the KIPP School's Student Riding Program at Meadowbrook. This program provides riding lessons and equipment, summer riding camp, meals and transportation for students at the KIPP College Preparatory School in Washington DC who are passionate about riding and horses but who would not otherwise be able to participate in riding programs.

Rules. Riders entering this class each collect a "Pledge Card" on which they declare sponsors for their performance. Each sponsor pledges a particular dollar amount per obstacle that is jumped clean within a time allowed, over a course of fences designed by the rider. A sponsor's total donation will be determined by how many jumps are completed in the allotted time. Pledge cards are available on our website, or in the show office on the day of the show.

- Each competitor has 60 seconds to jump all the obstacles he wishes in any order.
- An audible signal declares start and the finish of the round.
- Obstacles will be built to be jumped in either direction. Jumps will be set at 2'6".
- Each obstacle may be jumped only twice.
- A competitor will be credited for each obstacle jumped correctly.
- No credit is awarded for an obstacle knocked down. If the signal sounds at the moment when the horse is already taking off (front hooves off the ground), this obstacle counts if it is correctly jumped.
- All disobediences are penalized by the time lost by the competitor. The competitor must withdraw after a fall. Nevertheless he scores the pledge obtained up to the moment of his fall.

CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

Lead Line

Open to riders who have not reached their 8th birthday as of December 1 of the previous year, mounted on a pony. To be judged on equitation and suitability of mount at a walk. No martingales allowed. Children in this class are eligible for the Short Stirrup Equitation Division where permitted.

1. Lead Line Walk. (Only this class counts towards MHSA points.)
2. Lead Line Walk/Trot
3. Lead Line Walk, off lead.

Pre-Short Stirrup

Open to riders who have not reached their 11th birthday as of December 1 of the previous year. Judged on position of rider and suitability of mount to purpose. Riders not eligible for any other classes. Martingales are allowed.

4. Pre-Short Stirrup Walk. Shown on the line (optional) at a walk.
5. Pre-Short Stirrup Walk/Trot. Shown on the line at a walk and trot.
6. Pre-Short Stirrup Walk/Trot. Shown off the line at a walk and trot. Rider may be asked to demonstrate two-point position, halt and/or drop stirrups.

Mini-Stirrup

Open to all riders who have not reached their 9th birthday as of December 1 of the previous year. To be judged on suitability and control of mount. No martingales.

7. Mini-Stirrup Walk
8. Mini-Stirrup Walk/Trot
9. Mini-Stirrup Walk/Trot Combo. May be asked to go over obstacles not to exceed 12".

Long Stirrup Hunter

Open to adult riders and junior riders age 11 and up as of December 1 of the previous year. Open to horses and ponies. To be judged on manners and suitability.

11. Long Stirrup Hunter Walk/Trot
12. Long Stirrup Hunter Pleasure Walk/Trot
13. Long Stirrup Hunter Command Walk/Trot

Beginner Equitation

Open to junior and adult riders in their first or second year of showing, and who have not jumped higher than 18" in any open horse show. Judged on rider's position and control. No more than 4 riders may canter at a time; the judge has discretion to divide the class as appropriate. Martingales allowed in under saddle classes. Riders may only cross enter into Pleasure classes in Ring B.

14. Beginner Equitation On the Flat, Walk/Trot.
15. Beginner Equitation On the Flat, Walk/Trot/Canter.
16. Beginner Equitation Walk/Trot/Canter/Two 18" Xrails.

Maiden Equitation

Open to junior and amateur riders who have not jumper higher than 18" in any open horse show. Judged on rider's position and control. No more than 6-8 riders may canter at a time; the judge has discretion to divide the class as appropriate. Martingales allowed in under saddle classes. Riders may only cross enter into Pleasure classes in Ring B. No more than four jumps at 18".

17. Maiden Equitation On the Flat, Walk/Trot.
18. Maiden Equitation On the Flat, Walk/Trot/Canter.
19. Maiden Equitation Over Fences.

Meadowbrook Maiden Equitation Medal

Open to junior and adult riders who have shown in classes 14-19. To be shown over a course of six fences, 18" in height. Judged on seat, hands, guidance, and control of mount. Minimum of six entries, if available, to be judged on the flat or other tests of equitation the judge may feel appropriate. Martingales are to be removed for the flat phase.

20. Meadowbrook Maiden Equitation Medal

Long Stirrup Equitation

Open to adult riders and junior riders age 11 and up as of December 1 of the previous year. Open to horses and ponies. Judged on hands, seat, guidance, and control. No Martingales allowed in under saddle classes. Riders may only cross enter into Pleasure, Low Children's Hunter, and Low Pony. 4 Fences to be 18"-2'.

21. Long Stirrup Walk/Trot.
22. Long Stirrup Walk/Trot/Canter.
23. Long Stirrup Over Fences

Novice Equitation

Open to junior and adult amateur riders who have not jumped higher than 2'3" in any open horse show. Judged on rider's position and control. No more than 6-8 riders may canter at a time; the judge has discretion to divide the class as appropriate. Martingales allowed in under saddle classes. Riders may only cross enter into Pleasure classes in Ring B. No more than six jumps at 18"-2'.

24. Novice Equitation Over Fences.
25. Novice Equitation Over Fences.
26. Novice Equitation On the Flat.

Meadowbrook Novice Equitation Medal

Open to junior and adult riders who have shown in classes 21-26. To be shown over a course of six fences, 18"-2' in height. Judged on seat, hands, guidance, and control of mount. The judge may, at his or her discretion, test riders on the flat or require other tests. Martingales are to be removed for the flat phase.

27. Meadowbrook Novice Equitation Medal

Open Card Warm-up

Open card warm-up classes are open all day. They can be jumped at whatever the current height is in the ring.

- 10. Open Card Warm-up, Ring A
- 32. Open Card Warm-up, Ring B
- 72. Open Card Warm-up, Ring C

Short Stirrup Equitation

Open to ponies ridden by junior exhibitors that have not reached their 11th birthday as of December 1 of the previous year. Judged on seat, hands, guidance, and control A rider may only cross enter into the MHSA Regional Short Stirrup Hunter, MHSA Leadline where permitted, or other miscellaneous MHSA Regional Walk and Walk/Trot classes at the same show. No martingales allowed in under saddle classes. No oxers may be used. Fences shall be 18".

- 33. Short Stirrup Walk/Trot,
- 34. Short Stirrup Walk/Trot/Canter
- 35. Short Stirrup Over Fences. A minimum of four and a maximum of eight fences.

Short Stirrup Hunter

Open to ponies ridden by junior exhibitors that have not reached their 11th birthday as of December 1 of the previous year. A rider may only cross enter into the MHSA Short Stirrup Equitation, MHSA Regional Short Stirrup Equitation, MHSA Leadline where permitted, or other miscellaneous MHSA Regional Walk and Walk/Trot classes at the same show. Fences shall be 18". To be judged on performance, soundness, and suitability of mount.

- 36. Short Stirrup Hunter Over Fences
- 37. Short Stirrup Hunter Over Fences
- 38. Short Stirrup Hunter Under Saddle

Meadowbrook Short Stirrup Medal

Open to riders who have shown in classes 33-38. To be shown over a course of six fences, 18" in height. Judged on seat, hands, guidance, and control of mount. The judge may, at his or her discretion, test riders on the flat or require other tests. Martingales are to be removed for the flat phase.

- 39. Meadowbrook Short Stirrup Medal.

Pleasure Pony

Open to junior and adult amateur riders on ponies. Judged on performance, manners, way of going, suitability, and soundness. Martingales not allowed. Fences to be 2'.

- 40. Pleasure Pony. May be asked to stand quietly and back easily.
- 41. Pleasure Pony Hack. No more than 10 will be selected to jump two fences.
- 42. Pleasure Pony Over Fences.

Low Pony Hunter

Open to Junior riders on ponies. Judged on performance, manners, way of going, suitability, and soundness. Fences to be 2'.

- 43. Low Children's Pony Hunter Over Fences
- 44. Low Children's Pony Hunter Over Fences
- 45. Low Children's Pony Hunter Under Saddle

Junior Pony Equitation

Open to junior riders on ponies. To be judged on seat, hands, guidance and control of mount. Additional tests may be performed. Fences to be 2', 2'6".

- 46. Junior Pony Equitation Over Fences
- 47. Junior Pony Equitation on the Flat

Meadowbrook Pony Mini Equitation Medal

Open to junior riders on ponies. Judged on seat, hands, guidance, and control of mount. Fences to be 2' or 2'6", rider's choice. To be shown over a course of up to eight fences. The judge may, at his/her discretion, call back riders to be judged on the flat or other tests of equitation. Martingales to be removed for the flat phase.

- 48. Meadowbrook Pony Mini Equitation Medal

MHSA/VHSA Children's Pony Medal

Open to junior members of the MHSA on ponies. To jump eight fences of hunter type with or without wings. The course must contain an oxer, at least one change of direction and two of the following which may not be combined: a ending line, a narrow jump (8'), a roll back turn, a fence at the end of the ring or a long approach to a single fence. Small/medium ponies to jump 2' and large ponies to jump 2'6".

- 49. MHSA/VHSA Children's Pony Medal

HCHSA Pony Medal

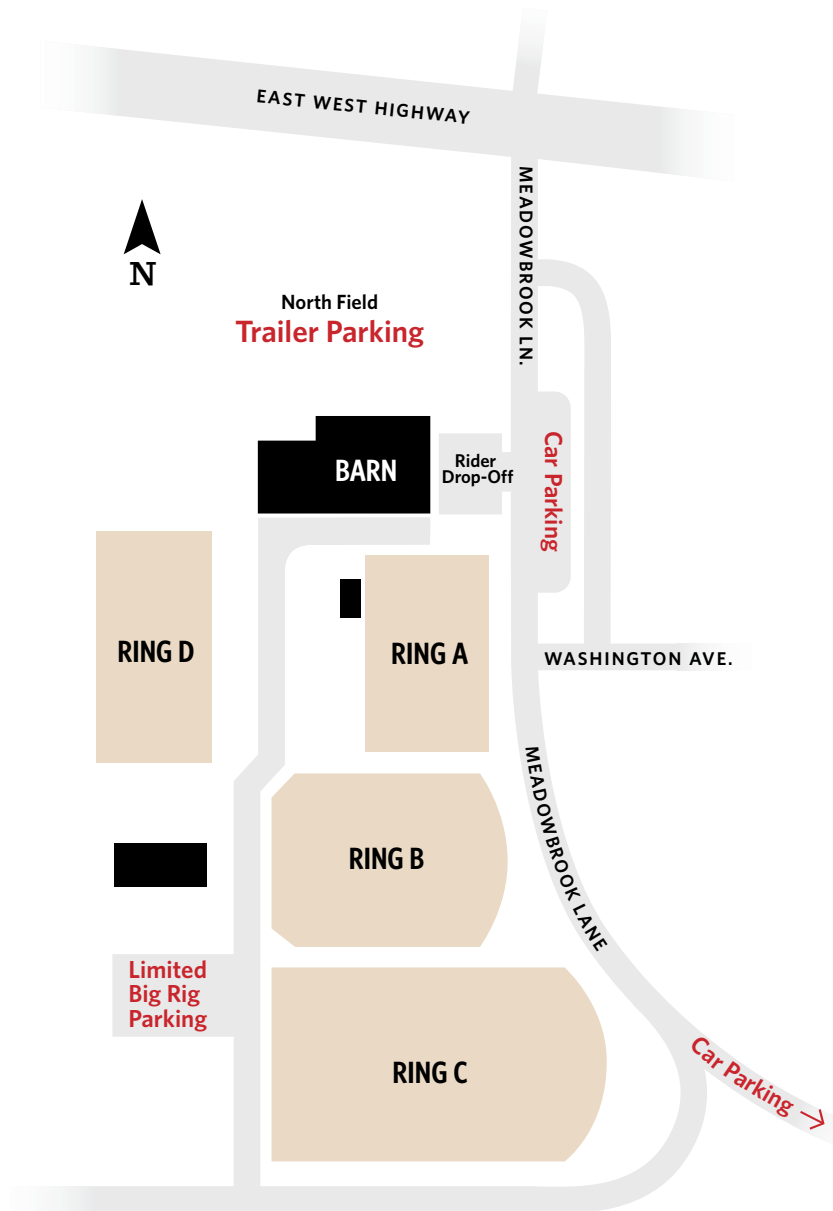
DIRECTIONS

Rings are located directly behind the barn.

Parking: Plenty of parking is available for both cars and trailers. Parking is on a first-come first-serve basis, with one minor exception: we reserve the few larger spaces behind the utility barn for big rig parking. With co-operation, there is room for three rigs in this area. All other trailers must park in the field north of the barn. Please use designated manure receptacles. **PLEASE DO NOT DUMP MANURE IN THE NORTH FIELD.** There are two designated car parking areas: one near the barn and the other in the Park Service storage lot. There are volunteers on hand in the early morning to direct traffic and answer any questions.
