ENTRIES:

All exhibitors must provide the show office with a current negative coggins report for each horse brought on the show grounds.

Entry form must be filled out completely, including all signatures, and must be accompanied by an open check before back numbers may be picked up. Online Entries are required via www.horseshowsonline.com. Pre-entries received by 5 pm the WEDNESDAY prior to the horse show will receive a \$10.00 discount

SCHOOLING:

Schooling will be permitted after 12:00 noon and until 7:00 PM the day before the show. Schooling will also be available prior to the start of the show on the day of competition as determined by the course designer.

COGGINS: All exhibitors must provide the show office with a current negative coggins report for each horse brought onto the show grounds, regardless if they are showing. If the horse is showing, the coggins must be shown prior to picking up back number.

STABLING:

Limited stabling is available. Stalls will be pre-bedded. Stall orders must be pre-paid by noon the Monday prior to the show. Stalls may be paid for by open check or Credit Card information. Please call or text your stall order in to **Tara Deckel (508-776-9247) by 12 PM, noon by the Monday prior to the show. Stall Fees must be paid for at time of reservation by open check or credit card.**

Please note stall fees are per DAY not per night.

AWARDS:

Six ribbons will be awarded in each class. Champion and Reserve Champion ribbons will be awarded in each division. VHSA Champions and Reserve will be calculated with only the first 2 jump classes awarded for points. This may result in separate champions for VHSA which will only count towards the VHSA points. The THIRD jumping class will not count towards VHSA points

CLASSES AND DIVISIONS

2, 3, 4. VHSA WORKING HUNTER – Open to all horses and ponies. Judged on performance, manners and way of going. Fences 2'6".

5, 6, 7, 8. GREEN HUNTER - Open to horses only in their first or second year of showing over fences at 2'6" or higher. Fences to be 2'6" and 3'. Both heights must be offered and judged together. To be eligible for green hunter status, horses may not have shown over fences 2'6" or higher prior to the current competition year. A horse is eligible for reinstatement of their 1st green year if they have not shown at more than (3) shows over fences at 2'6" or higher prior to August 1st of the competition year upon application to the SWVHJA office. The application will be reviewed by the Board of Directors. Horses are eligible for (1) reinstatement of Green status. SWVHJA Recognized.

9, 10, 11, 12. LOW HUNTER - Open to horses and ponies. To be judged on performance, manners, and way of going. Fences 3'. If there are fewer than 3 horses in the Low Hunter Division, it may be combined with the Working Hunter Division. A horse that is eligible for more than one section must be declared and compete in only one. Horses will jump the respective height for the entered division.

13, 14, 15, 16. WORKING HUNTER - Open to horses. To be judged on performance, manners, and way of going. Fences 3'3" or 3'6". If there are fewer than 3 horses in the Working Hunter Division, it may be combined with the Low Hunter Division. A horse that is eligible for more than one section must be declared and compete in only one. Horses will jump the respective height for the entered division.

17, 18, 19, 20. ADULT AMATEUR HUNTER - Open to adult amateur riders mounted on horses or ponies. To be judged on performance, manners, and way of going. Ponies shown by an adult may not be shown in the Pony Hunter division at the same horse show. Fences 3'. Management may combine this division with the Children's Hunter division if there are fewer than 3 entries.

21, 22, 23, 24. CHILDREN'S HUNTER - Open to juniors mounted on horses. To be judged on performance, manners, and way of going. Fences 3'. Management may combine this division with the Adult Amateur Hunter division if there are fewer than 3 entries.

25, 26, 27. ADULT HUNTER PLEASURE HORSE– Open to horses ridden by an adult.

28, 29, 30. HUNTER PLEASURE PONY - Open to juniors mounted on ponies.

31, 32, 33. JR. HUNTER PLEASURE HORSE–Open to horses ridden by a junior.

34, 35, 36. PLEASURE HUNTER - Open to all horses and ponies. Judged on performance, manners and way of going. Fences to be 18" and 2'. No oxers.

37, 38, 39, 40. PRE-BEGINNER EQUITATION–Open to Junior and Amateur Riders in their first year of showing over fences less than 2' in height. Riders are eligible for one horse show year and may not enter divisions with fence height 2' or above. This division will not count against the rider's one year eligibility for the Beginner Equitation division. To be judged on rider's position and control. Division may be combined with Beginner Equitation division at managements discretion if entries warrant. Fence height 18". No oxers permitted.

86, 87, 88. SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION: Open to riders 12 years of age and under. To be judged on rider's position and control. Riders may not cross enter into the SWVHJA Beginner Equitation or any division with fences over 2'. The division consists of one walk/trot class, one walk/trot/canter class, and one over fences class with fences not to exceed 18".

CLASSES AND DIVISIONS

41, 42, 43, 44. BEGINNER EQUITATION – Open to junior and amateur riders in their first year of showing over fences 2' in height. No oxers permitted. Riders are eligible for one horse show year and may not enter divisions with fence heights exceeding 2'. This division will not count against rider's 2 year eligibility for the Intermediate Hunter division. To be judged on rider's position and control. Division may be split between juniors and adults at the discretion of show management.

45, 46, 47. HOPEFUL HUNTER -Open to all horses and ponies. Judged on performance, manners and way of going. Fences 2'3".

48, 49, 50, 51. INTERMEDIATE HUNTER - Open to anyone in their first or second year of showing, on horses or ponies, excluding the Pre-Beginner and Beginner Equitation division. Fences 2'3". Once a rider shows over fences 2'6" or higher they are no longer eligible for the Intermediate Hunter division in subsequent years. To be judged on performance, manners, and way of going. The rider may not jump higher than 2'6" at the same horse show.

52, 53, 54, 55. SMALL/MEDIUM PONY HUNTER - Open to ponies ridden by juniors. Ponies shown in this division may not be shown by an adult in any recognized division at the same horse show. Judged on performance, manners, and way of going. Small ponies (not to exceed 12.2h) to jump 2', medium ponies (over 12.2h - not to exceed 13.2h) to jump 2'3". Divisions must be offered split, but if there are not three ponies in either the Small/Medium or Large Pony Divisions, the divisions must be combined. Lines less than 72' must be set on appropriate distances.

56, 57, 58, 59. LARGE PONY HUNTER - Open to ponies ridden by juniors. Ponies shown in this division may not be shown by an adult in any recognized division at the same horse show. Judged on performance, manners, and way of going. Large ponies (over 13.2h - not to exceed 14.2h) to jump 2'6". Divisions must be offered split, but if there are not three ponies in either the Small/Medium or Large Pony divisions, the divisions must be combined. Lines less than 72' must be set on appropriate distances.

60, 61, 62, 63. SPECIAL CHILDREN'S HUNTER - Same specs as the Special Adult Hunter, except open to junior riders.

64, 65, 66, 67. SPECIAL ADULT HUNTER - Open to Adult Amateur riders mounted on horses or ponies. Fences to be 2'6" or 2'9". Both heights must be offered and judged together. Related distances between two jumps should be no less than 60' (4 strides). Judged on performance, manners, and way of going. Horse/rider combination cannot compete over fences higher than 2'9" at the same horse show. Ponies shown by an adult may not be shown in the pony hunter division at the same horse show. The Special Adult Hunter division and the Special Children's Hunter division may be combined if there are fewer than 3 in either section

68, 69, 70. SCHOOLING HUNTER– Open to all horses and ponies. Judged on performance, manners and way of going. Fences 2'6".

71, 72, 73., 74– THOROUGHRED HUNTER– Limited to horses who are registered or eligible to be registered with the Jockey Club. To be judged on performance, manners, and way of going. To be shown at 2'6" or 3' in height. Both heights must be offered and judged together.

89, 90, 90. SHORT STIRRUP HUNTER: Open to horses and ponies ridden by children 12 years and under, however, shows may specify a lower age limit, i.e., 10 years and under. The division will consist of three (3) classes, two over fence classes and a walk, trot, canter under saddle class. Short Stirrup riders, ponies and horses may not cross enter into any other division shown over 2' or a SWVHJA recognized Equitation Class with the exception of Junior Equitation On The Flat (14 and Under) and Pleasure Pony or Pleasure Horse at any show in which they exhibit in the Short Stirrup Division. Short Stirrup riders will be limited to no more than two (2) entries in the Short Stirrup Division at any one horse show. The jump height for this division shall be decided by individual horse shows, but should be no lower than 18" and no higher than 2' with a minimum of four (4) jumps. The Short Stirrup division cannot be combined with any other Division.

CLASSES AND DIVISIONS

76. JUNIOR EQUITATION ON THE FLAT 14 & Under - Open to riders who have not reached their 15th birthday by December 1st of the calendar year. To be shown at a walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring and judged on position, control, and guidance. USEF tests 1-19 may be used, excluding those requiring work over fences. Three entries are necessary to fill this class. Riders need not be members of SWVHJA to compete. If there are insufficient entries, this class may be combined with the Junior Equitation on the Flat 15-17 and/or the Adult Equitation on the flat.

77. JUNIOR EQUITATION ON THE FLAT 15-17 - Open to riders who have reached their 15th birthday by December 1st of the calendar year, but not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st of the calendar year. To be shown at a walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring and judged on position, control, and guidance. USEF tests 1- 19 may be used, excluding those requiring work over fences. Three entries are necessary to fill this class. Riders need not be members of SWVHJA to compete. If there are insufficient entries, this class may be combined with the Junior Equitation on the Flat 14 & under and/or the Adult Equitation on the flat.

78. SWVHJA ADULT MEDAL -MUST BE A MEMBER TO COMPETE IN THE CLASS Same specs as for the SWVHJA Hunter Seat Medal Class, except open to amateur riders 18 years of age and older. Ponies may be ridden by adults, but may not be shown in the Pony Hunter division at the same horse show. If there are fewer than four entries, this class can be combined with the Hunter Seat Medal. SWVHJA Adult Medal contestants may compete throughout the year. The top twenty (20) point earners, with a minimum of 10 points, will be invited to compete in the Adult Medal Finals.

79. SWVHJA HUNTER SEAT MEDAL - MUST BE A MEMBER TO COMPETE IN THE CLASS Open to riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st of the calendar year. To be shown over a course of fences not to exceed 3' that must include two changes of direction, a combination and at least three oxers. A minimum of six riders, if available, must be called back to work on the flat. Martingales may not be used in the flat phase. Each phase to count 50%. Same horse must be used for both phases. To qualify for the finals, a rider must accumulate 20 points during the show year. Four entries are required to fill the class with a minimum of three to complete the class. If there are fewer than four entries, this class can be combined with the Adult Medal. SWVHJA Hunter Seat Medal contestants may compete throughout the year. The top twenty (20) point earners, with a minimum of 10 points, will be invited to compete in the Hunter Seat Medal Finals.

80. VHSA ADULT AMATEUR MEDAL CLASS: Open to horses only. Rider must be a member of VHSA prior to entry in the class according to Article II, 3. and must hold a current amateur card issued by USEF. To be shown over a course of not less than six (6) obstacles at three (3) feet, which must include one combination and two changes of direction. All VHSA Medal Class courses must have at least two of the following inside the course: a roll back turn, a broken or bending line, an end jump, a narrow jump, or a long ride to a single jump. Riders may not compete in any class where the fence height exceeds 3 feet, 3 inches (1.0m) with the exception of the Childrens/Adult Jumper division, at the same show, where a rider may not jump higher than 3'9" (1.15m). This also applies to the show hosting the VHSA Adult/Children's Hunter Medal Finals. The judge must call back at least four exhibitors for further testing over fences.. Jumping faults of mount not to count. Fall of horse or rider or three disobediences shall eliminate a contender. There must be at least three (3) exhibitors to fill the class and three (3) exhibitors must complete the course in order for that particular class to count. Six Ribbons. This Class can be combined with the VHSA Children's Medal. In the Finals, same testing applies.

75. ADULT EQUITATION ON THE FLAT - Open to amateurs 18 years of age and older. To be shown at a walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring and judged on position, control, and guidance. USEF tests 1-19 may be used, excluding those requiring work over fences. Three entries are necessary to fill this class. Riders need not be members of SWVHJA to compete. If there are insufficient entries, this class may be combined with the Junior Equitation on the flat. Riders must stay within their age group if classes are split by age.

81.VHSA CHILDREN'S MEDAL CLASS: Open to Junior members of VHSA who have not reached their 18th birthday. Riders may not compete in any class where the fence height exceeds 3 feet, 3 inches (1.0m) with the exception of the Childrens/Adult Jumper division, at the same show, where a rider may not jump higher than 3'9" (1.15m). Rider must be a member of VHSA prior to entry in the class according to Article II, 3. Open to horses only. To be shown over a course of not less than six (6) obstacles at three (3) feet, which must include one combination and two changes of direction. All VHSA Medal Class courses must have at least two of the following inside the course: a roll back turn, a broken or bending line, an end jump, a narrow jump, or a long ride to a single jump. This also applies to the show hosting the VHSA Adult/Children's Hunter Medal Finals. The judge must call back at least four exhibitors for further testing over fences. Fall of horse or rider or three disobediences shall eliminate a contender. There must be at least three (3) exhibitors to fill the class and three (3) exhibitors must complete the course in order for that particular class to count. Six Ribbons. This Medal can be combined with the VHSA Adult Medal. In the Finals, same testing applies.

82. SWVHJA PONY MEDAL - MUST BE A MEMBER TO COMPETE IN THE CLASS Open to current junior members of SWVHJA mounted on ponies. To be shown over a minimum of 6 jumps at the appropriate heights. A minimum of six riders, if available, must be called back to work on the flat. Martingales may not be used in the flat phase. Each phase to count 50%. The same pony must be used for both phases. Four entries are required to fill the class with a minimum of three to complete the class. If no Pony Medal is offered, a rider may compete on a pony in the Hunter Seat Medal. A rider cannot compete in both the Pony and the Hunter Seat Medals in one show, nor can they participate in both aforementioned finals in one year. SWVHJA Pony Medal contestants may compete throughout the year. The top twenty (20) point earners, with a minimum of 10 points, will be invited to compete in the Pony Medal Finals.

83. HOLLINS MEDAL— Open to junior and adult amateur riders who have not qualified for the SWVHJA Hunter Seat Medal, SWVHJA Adult Medal, or the Oakridge Medal during the existing or previous year; qualifiers for the SWVHJA Pony medal are still eligible. The class will consist of 2 phases, each counting for 50% of the total score. First phase shall be shown over a course of fences and will not contain a combination. The second phase will be a flat phase, shown at the walk, trot, and canter both directions of the ring. The same horse must be used for both phases. Martingales are permitted in the flat phase.

84. SWEET BRIAR COLLEGE MEDAL— Open to juniors and amateurs. To be shown over a course of no less than 6 jumps at 2'9". Course must include 2 changes of direction, and may contain an in and out. The judge will then have the option of testing the top 4 riders. Tests 1-10 may be used. The same horse must be used in both phases. Three competitors must complete the course for points to count. Riders may not have shows in a 3'6" or higher Equitation medal class, and may not jump higher than 2'9" at the same show. This class may be combined with other classes of similar specifications. This class is not recognized or sanctioned by SWVHJA. Finals will be held at the Sweet Briar College Winter Horse Show in December. To qualify for the finals, a rider must accumulate 20 points, or be in the top 15 point earners for the year. Riders may continue to compete throughout the year.

85. LEADLINE—Open to riders six years of age and under. Riders may not cross enter into any other class at the horse show.

101. \$500 MHS JR/AM CLASSIC- Open to horses and ponies showing in the Pleasure Hunter, Hopeful Hunter, Intermediate, Small/Medium Ponies, Large Pony Division, Special Child and Special Adult Divisions. . Horses must be ridden by a Junior or Amateur rider. The second round of your division will count as your first round score. The top 12 will return for a second round on their respective day. Division must be declared at time of entry. Double points will be awarded in respective SWVHJA sanctioned divisions if there are more than 10 entries.
