- ❖ Entries: \$40.00 a division or \$20 a class

Rules and Regulations:

1. Foxtail Farm will not be responsible for any accident, injury, or loss of property on the grounds before, during, or after any event.
2. Foxtail Farm reserves the right to refuse any entry; to change the time schedule; to combine classes; or change judges at any time.
3. Six ribbons will be awarded in each class except the classic which will award 10 ribbons. Divisions will award champion and reserve ribbons.
4. ASTM approved hard hats must be worn at all times while mounted by juniors and adults.
5. Schooling is available one hour prior to the start of the show.
6. Formal Show attire not required.
7. Adds/Drops are allowed during the show for no extra charge.
8. Proof of current negative Coggins is required for each entry.

Pre-Beginner Equitation: Open to all riders in their first year of showing. First Class will be Walk only, Second two classes are optional assisted walk-trot. Riders will be asked to walk, demonstrate two-point position at the walk, and trot one at a time with optional assistance. Riders may only cross-enter into Beginner Pleasure.

Walk-Trot Equitation: Open to riders in their first or second year of showing. Riders will be asked to walk, trot, demonstrate sitting trot, and two point position at the trot. Riders may not cross enter into any class where cantering is required.

Beginner Pleasure: Open to horses and ponies to be judged on the horse's movement and suitability as a pleasurable beginner mount. Riders should be in their first or second year of showing and may not cross enter into any class where cantering is required.

Short/Long Stirrup Equitation: First two classes over 4 12-18 inch crossrails. Flat class is Walk-Trot only. Course may be trotted or cantered. Simple changes permitted. Riders may only cross-enter into Walk-Trot, Pleasure, Short Stirrup, and VHSa Eq on the flat.

Short/Long Stirrup Hunter: First two classes over fences no more than 18" high, third class is Walk/Trot/Canter. Courses are to be simple and may be trotted or cantered.

Pleasure Horse/Pony: Open to horses and ponies to be judged on the horse's movement and suitability as a pleasurable hunter mount. Adults may ride ponies. Class will split between horses and ponies if entries warrant.

Open/Working Hunter: Follows VHSa Associate Working Hunter guidelines. Offered at 2', 2'6, or 3'. Only horses jumping 2'6 and higher will be eligible for VHSa Associate points.

Baby Green Hunter: Open to Horses or Ponies in their first year of showing over fences. Fences 2' or 2'3. Adults may ride ponies.

Thoroughbred Hunter: Follows VHSa Associate Working Hunter guidelines. Offered at 2'6, 2'9 or 3'.

Green Hunter: Follows VHSa Associate Working Hunter guidelines. Offered at 2'6, 2'9, or 3' Green ponies to jump 2', 2'3, or 2'6. Ponies and Horses will be split if entries warrant.

Children's and Adult Hunters: Follows VHSa Associate Working Hunter guidelines. Offered at 2'6, or 3'. Classes may be combined if entries are insufficient.

VHSa Equitation on the Flat: Follows the VHSa Associate guidelines. Classes maybe combined if entries are insufficient.

VHSa Equitation Over Fences: Follows VHSa Associate guidelines. Offered at regulation pony heights for ponies and 2'6 or 3' for jr/adults.

Student Equitation: Open to junior or amateur riders. Jump height is 18"- 2' and course will not have oxers. Rider may NOT enter into any other Equitation over fences class and may only cross enter into Open Hunter, Special Hunter or Short Stirrup Hunter and may not compete at a height higher than 2'3. Adults may ride ponies. Simple changes will not be penalized.

Open Hunter: Open to all riders on horses or ponies. Adults may ride ponies. Fence heights - 2' or 2'3". No oxers
