🐾 **Pre-Entry Fees:**

Classes: \$25, Divisions: \$50, Warm Up: \$20, Challenge: \$45, Classic: \$30

🐾 **Entry Fees after 12:00 Sept 10, 2019:**

Classes: \$30, Divisions: \$60, Warm Up: \$25, Challenge: \$50, Classic: \$35

🐾 **Stalls Fee:**

\$30 day of show only. (Payable to **Crafty Fox Farm**)

🐾 Entry **MUST** be paid at time of entry or covered by a signed check left with show secretary. If payment is not made at the show, a processing fee of \$25 will be added. Return check fee: \$35

🐾 Please make checks payable to **Virginia Beach Horse Show Association (VBHSA)**.

🐾 Six ribbons will be awarded in each class, with the exception of the Challenge Class and the Cooler Show Classic, which will have eight

🐾 Championship and Reserve ribbons will be awarded in each division

🐾 The Judge's decision is final.

🐾 Hard hats must be worn while mounted

🐾 All dogs must be on a leash at all times

## VBHSA Challenge Class

**Objective**

To offer a class that shows the overall ability of horse and rider. This class will recognize the trainer, owner of the horse, parents of the rider and class sponsors. It is open to juniors and amateurs. The class is to be judged on the best overall horse and rider combination.

**Class Requirements**

The class will run in the format of the Hunter Classic. No entries will be accepted once the class has started. There will be two rounds ridden over two different courses. Numerical scores will be announced at the completion of each horse/rider's trip. The top 12 rounds will be classed back and will ride the second course in reverse scoring order (lowest score starting first), within jump heights.

**Jump Heights**

Small Ponies 2' Medium Ponies 2'3" Large Ponies 2'9" Horses: 3'

**Rules of the course**

- ▲ The first course and second course will have 8-10 fences.
- ▲ Each round is worth 50% of your total score.
- ▲ The scores will be announced upon completion of each round
- ▲ Each rider must wear protective headgear in accordance with general rules.
- ▲ Mane braiding and proper show attire is required.
- ▲ Adults may ride ponies.
- ▲ Owner, rider and animal must be VBHSA member 30 days prior to cooler show.

- ▲ First Place: \$200, Perpetual Trophy and Ribbon
- ▲ Second Place: \$125 and Ribbon
- ▲ Third Place: \$75 and Ribbon
- ▲ Fourth Place: \$50 and Ribbon
- ▲ Fifth Place: \$30 and Ribbon
- ▲ Sixth Place: \$20 and Ribbon
- ▲ Seventh Place: Ribbon
- ▲ Eighth Place: Ribbon

### VBHSA Cooler Show Classic

#### Objective

To offer a class that shows the overall ability of horse and rider. This class will recognize the trainer, owner of the horses, parents of the rider and class sponsors. It is open to juniors and amateurs. The class is to be judged on the best overall horse and rider combination.

#### Class Requirements

The class will run in the format of the Hunter Classic. No entries will be accepted once the class has started. There will be two rounds ridden over two different courses. #### Jump Heights

2' or 2'6" (Rider's Choice)
