All Classes and Divisions are BHSa eligible, with the exception of the California Warm-Up.

Directions to Oakland Heights Farm

From 64: Take I64 to Rt. 15 North (Zion Crossroads exit). Follow Rt. 15 north through Gordonsville circle for approx. 3.5 miles. U-turn after passing show grounds to OHF on the right.

From Fredericksburg: Take Rt. 3 to Rt. 20 west. Follow Rt. 20 west to the town of Orange. Turn left onto Rt. 15 south. OHF is approx. 6 miles on the right.

From Culpeper: Take Rt. 15 south through the town of Orange. Continue on Rt. 15 south approx. 6 miles to OHF on the right.

Leadline – Open to children 7 years and younger as of 12/1/18. Riders not allowed to cross enter into any classes where they would be asked to trot. Points go to rider.

Pre-Short Stirrup Equitation – Open to riders 10 years & under as of 12/1/18. Riders may not cross enter into any classes where they would be asked to canter or jump.

Short Stirrup Equitation – Open to Juniors 12 years & under as of 12/1/18. Judged on equitation. Riders may not cross enter into classes where they would jump over 18". Courses may be trotted.

Pleasure Pony – Open to ponies ridden by Juniors. To be judged on manners, suitability, soundness, and way of going. May be combined with Adult Pleasure Horse or Junior Pleasure Horse divisions.

VHSA/BHSA Pony Equitation – Open to ponies ridden by Juniors. Fences: Small 2'0", Medium 2'3", Large 2'6". The judge may select at least ¼ of the class to show at the walk/trot/canter and to perform additional tests at the judge's discretion.

Pony Hunter – Open to ponies ridden by Juniors. The division will be split to small/medium and large ponies if entries warrant. Fences: Small 2'0", Medium 2'3", Large 2'6". May be combined with the Green Hunter pony division.

Green Pony Hunter – Open to ponies in their first year of showing at regulation heights as of 12/1/17 ridden by Juniors. Fences: Small 2'0", Medium 2'3", Large 2'6". May be combined with the regular Pony Hunter division.

Equitation on the Flat – Open to juniors on horses or ponies, and adult amateurs on horses not entered in a pony division. To be shown at walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring and judged on position, control, and guidance. Tests 1-19 may be used, excluding those requiring work over fences. May be split: Juniors (14 and under), Juniors (15-17), and Adults, if entries warrant.

Pleasure Horse – Open to any horse. To be judged on manners, suitability, soundness, and way of going. May be split: Junior/Adult, if entries warrant. May be combined with Pleasure Pony division.

Maiden Hunter – Open to horses and ponies in their first year of showing over fences at 2' or higher as of 12/1/2018. No restrictions on riders. Jump height minimum of 2'. May be trotted.

Low Hunter – Open to horses and ponies. No restrictions on riders. Fences: 2'0".

Schooling Hunter – Open to all horses and ponies not entered in a pony division. Fences: 2'6". May combine with Working or Low divisions.

Green Hunter – Open to horses in their first or second year of showing over fences at 2'6" or higher as of 12/1/17. Fences: 2'6". May be combined with Working or Green or Maiden divisions.

Thoroughbred Hunter – Open to thoroughbreds who are registered with or are eligible to be registered with the Jockey Club. Fences 2'6". May be combined with Green or Working Hunter in order to fill. VHSA & BHSa

VHSA/BHSA Children's/Adult Amateur Equitation – Open to horses ridden by Juniors and Adult Amateurs. Adults may ride ponies not entered in a pony division. Fences: 2'6" or 3'0". The judge may select at least ¼ of the class to show at the walk/trot/canter and to perform additional tests at the judge's discretion. May be split Children/Adult if entries warrant.

Children's/Adult Amateur Hunter – Open to horses ridden by Juniors and Adult Amateurs. Adults may ride ponies not entered in a pony division. Fences: 2'6" or 3'0". May be split Children/Adult if entries warrant.

Working Hunter – Open to all horses and ponies not entered in a pony division. Fences: 3'0". May be combined with Green Hunter or Schooling Hunter divisions.

SHOW RULES

1. **ASTM/SEI certified protective headgear with harness must be worn by ALL RIDERS when mounted.** Proper attire is required. Jackets may be excused by the judge.
2. Class Specification – Every class offered herein, which is covered by the rules and regulations of the current BHSA and VHSA rule book, will be conducted and judged accordingly.
3. The judge's decision is final. Do not approach the judge, unless by way of show manager.
4. All ages are as of December 1, 2018.
5. All horses/ponies on show grounds must leave a *negative coggins test* with the Secretary, taken within one year for each entry.
6. Entries are \$15 per class. Non Showing fee of \$25 for the day. \$20 per Derby entry (no pre-entry discount on Derby).
7. Entries must leave a blank check with the show secretary upon registering. \$50.00 will be charged for returned checks. No back numbers will be given out without a blank check on hold for the number.
8. Pre-Entries: \$12 per class. Find GOOGLE FORM on Facebook or email oaklandheightsfarm@gmail.com DUE by 9PM Wednesday before the show.
9. Entries will not be accepted without the release on the entry form signed. If you pre-entered, please visit the Secretary's Stand to sign the waiver. No back numbers will be given out without a signed waiver.
10. Points will be counted 10, 6, 4, 2, 1, .5, Champion 10, Reserve Champion 6. Point system is in accordance with VHSA bonus point system.
11. Show management reserves the right to refuse entries, cancel and/or combine any class or division it deems necessary.
12. Exhibitors show at their own risk. In case of a fall, rider may not remount inside the ring.
13. Schooling will be allowed in the ring the morning of the show and at designated times. Show management reserves the right to split or to terminate schooling. Please see DAY OF schedules for schooling times.
14. 2019 Year-End awards will be given Champion and Reserve Champion.

Oakland Heights Farm, Four Horse Shoes Youth Foundation, any officials, and employees related to the foundation, and its board of directors, will not be held responsible for any accident or loss which may occur to any exhibitor, spectator, groom, property, or animal at the show. Participants and spectators alike understand that horses are inherently unpredictable and dangerous and that equipment and ground conditions are equally unpredictable; and knowingly choose to participate and/or spectate, taking full responsibility for this choice. \$20 per class – The **HUNTER DERBY** is ridden as a **HANDY HUNTER** class, with emphasis on brilliance and athletic ability from the horse. Option fences, will be set 3”-6” higher than base height. Riders are encouraged to ride more difficult routes and options.

Requirements to enter: Horses and ponies must show in the following divisions, with respect to their qualifications – Working Hunter, Children’s/Adult Amateur Hunter, Green Horse, Thoroughbred Hunter, Pony Hunter/Green Pony Hunter.

Pony/Green Pony Derby Open to ponies/juniors. Ponies will jump their base height.

Green Horse/Thoroughbred Derby Open to horses that rode in the Green and Thoroughbred Divisions.

Jr/Sr Derby Open to horses. Class may be split only if there are *eight* or more in each age group. Base height will be determined by height jumped in their respective division.

Prize money awarded to 1st – 3rd place!
