AND AMATEURS AT 2', 2'6", 3'. THE DERBY WILL BE HELD
AFTER THE FIRST SCHOOLING BREAK AND BEFORE THE
VHSA EQUITATION ON THE FLAT CLASSES.

Ring #1: 150' X 310' with all-weather footing
Ring #2: 90' X 110' with all-weather footing

DIRECTIONS

From Richmond:

Take Interstate 95 North to Exit 130B. Follow Rt. 3 West to Culpeper for approx. 8 miles to right at light (Rt. 610, Ely's Ford Road). Travel 4.7 miles to Whitestone Farm on your right.

From Washington:

Take Interstate 95 South to Exit 130B. Follow Rt. 3 West to Culpeper for approx. 8 miles to right at light (Rt. 610, Ely's Ford Road). Travel 4.7 miles to Whitestone Farm on your right.

From Warrenton:

Follow Rt. 15/29 South for approx. 11 miles. Turn left on Alanthus Road then take immediate left onto Brandy Road to immediate right onto Carrico Mills Road. Travel 5.8 miles to left onto Rt. 3 East towards Fredericksburg. Upon reaching Wilderness, continue for another 5.4 miles to Route 610, Ely's Ford Road (at light). Take a left onto Ely's Ford Road and travel 4.7 miles. Whitestone Farm will be on your right.

From Orange:

Take Route 20 North towards Fredericksburg. Travel Route 3 East towards Fredericksburg for 5.4 miles to Route 610, Ely's Ford Road (at light). Take a left onto Ely's Ford Road and travel 4.7 miles to Whitestone Farm on your right

California Warm up

One warm-up trip per horse/rider combination. Will run all day. Fence height determined by class offerings. **This class not judged.**

Lead Line

Open to children 7 and under - riders not to have reached their 8th birthday as of Dec. 1, 2022. Riders may not cross-enter into any class where they would be asked to trot. BHS A recognized class is class #4.

Pre-Short Preview Eq.

Open to Leadline and beginner riders 10 and under – not attached to a leadline but with a helper walking nearby. Riders may only cross enter into Pre-Short Stirrup Eq. Walk (class #5)

Pre-Short Stirrup Eq.

Open to riders 10 and under. Riders may be asked to walk, trot, and perform simple equitation tasks. Riders may not cross enter into classes where they would be asked to canter or jump. Riders not to have reached their 11th birthday as of Dec. 1, 2022.

CRC Public Relations Short Stirrup Eq.

Open to riders 12 and under. Riders may not cross enter into classes where they would jump over 18". May trot fences. Riders not to have reached their 13th birthday as of Dec. 1, 2022. The CRC Public Relations Perpetual Trophy kindly donated by the Greg Mueller family

Long Stirrup Eq.

Open to riders 13 and older who have never shown at 2' or higher. Riders may not cross enter into classes where they would jump over 18". May trot fences.

Student Equitation

Open to riders of any age in their 1st or 2nd year of showing o/f at 2' or higher as of Dec. 1, 2022. Riders are limited to two years only in this division whether they compete o/f or not. May trot fences.

Pleasure Pony

Open to ponies ridden by juniors shown with hunter tack. To be judged on manners, suitability, soundness, and way of going.

American Heritage Homes Green Pony Hunter

Open to ponies ridden by juniors. Ponies must be in their first year of showing as of Dec. 1, 2022 in any class that requires ponies to jump the designated height for green ponies. Fences 2' for small, 2'3" for medium and 2'6" for large ponies. This perpetual trophy donated by American Heritage Homes. www.ahhva.com

Ultimate Pontiac, Buick, GMC Pony Hunter

Open to ponies ridden by juniors. Fences 2' for small, 2'3" for medium, and 2'6" for large ponies. The Large Pony Perpetual Trophy donated by Ultimate Pontiac, Buick, GMC. www.driveULTIMATE.com

Whitestone Farm/VHSA Associate/BHSA Children's and Adult Amateur Pony Equitation

Open to juniors mounted on ponies. Fences 2' for small, 2'3" for medium and 2'6" for large ponies. The judge may select at least 1/4 of the class to return to show at a walk, trot, and canter, and to perform additional tests at the judge's discretion.

Pleasure Horse

Open to horses shown with hunter tack. To be judged on manners, suitability, soundness, and way of going. Division can be split if entries warrant.

VHSA Equitation on the Flat

Open to juniors on horses or ponies, and adults on horses or ponies not entered in a pony division. To be shown at a w-t-c both ways of the ring and judged on position, control, and guidance. Tests #1-19 may be used, excluding those requiring work o/f. May be split: Juniors (14 & under), Juniors (15-17), and Adult Amateurs if entries warrant.

Cowles Parkway Ford Maiden Hunter

Open to horses and ponies in their first year of showing over fences at 2' or higher as of Dec. 1, 2022. No restrictions on riders. Fences 2' and may be trotted. This perpetual trophy donated by Cowles Parkway Ford of Woodbridge. www.fordtrucksusa.com

Limit Rider Hunter

Open to juniors and adult amateurs who are not entered in any classes jumping 2'6" or higher. Horses and ponies may cross enter into other divisions. Riders are not eligible for Adult AM. Eq, Pony Eq. or Children's Eq. O/F

Dae Won Construction Low Hunter

Open to horses and ponies. No restrictions on riders. Fences 2' or 2'3". This perpetual trophy donated by Dae Won Construction Company, Inc.

Betty Milone Memorial Green Hunter

Open to horses in their 1st or 2nd year of showing over fences at 2'6" or higher as of Dec. 1, 2022. Fences 2'6". This perpetual trophy, donated by Carol Hawley and Kathleen Bonner, is dedicated to the memory of our dear horse show friend.

Thoroughbred Hunter

Open to Thoroughbreds registered with the Jockey Club or eligible to be registered. Fences 2'6"

Forrest Linton Memorial Working Hunter

Open to all horses and ponies not entered in a pony division. Fences 2'6", 2'9" or 3'. In order for points to count for BHSA, horse must jump at least 2'9". This perpetual trophy donated by Mr. and Mrs. Hunter Morin is dedicated to the memory of a much-loved local trainer and friend.

Jeff Pittman Memorial Children's/Adult Amateur Hunter

Open to juniors on horses and adult amateurs on horses or ponies not ridden in a pony division. Fences at 2'6" or 3'. Division will be split if entries warrant. This perpetual trophy is dedicated to the memory of Jeff Pittman – a beloved friend of the Quad J Farm family.

Whitestone Farm/VHSA Associate/BHSA Children's and Adult Amateur Eq.

Open to juniors on horses and adult amateurs mounted on horses or ponies not ridden in a pony division. Fences at 2'6" or 3'. The judge may select at least 1/4 of the class to return to show at a walk, trot, and canter, and to perform additional tests at the judge's discretion. Class will be split if entries warrant.

SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Every class offered herein is governed by the rules and specifications set by the current VHSA and BHSA rules.
2. Proof of a negative Coggins test, taken within 1 year, is required of all horses and ponies on the show grounds. A copy of your Coggins test will be required at each show.
3. **Pre-entries: Go online to: www.whitestonefarmva.com to submit or print a form. The entry form must be mailed or submitted by email and received by Wednesday at noon.** Pre-entries may add/scratch during the show without penalty. Call Kathleen at 540-840-5484 with questions.
4. All release/entry forms must be completed and signed by a participant or parent/guardian. Numbers will not be released until the entry form is signed.
5. **All classes are \$18.00 for pre-entries. Pre-entries must be received by 12:00 p.m. on the Wednesday before the show.** After that, entries are \$25/class.
6. There are no stall rentals.
7. Fee for returned checks \$50.00. Any requirement to bill for charges will be assessed a \$25.00 charge.
8. There is a \$25.00 non-showing fee for those who only wish to school.
9. Schooling in Ring #1 at designated times. Please see class schedule for details.
10. **NO DOGS ALLOWED.**
11. All Judges decisions are final.
12. ASTM/SEI certified helmets must be worn by all riders when mounted.
13. Age of junior rider is defined as riders age as of December 1, 2022.
14. Proper attire is required. Jackets may be excused at Judge's discretion.
15. All Hunter divisions horse/pony must be shown in at least one over fences class in order for under saddle points to count towards year end awards.
16. Six ribbons will be awarded in each class. Champion and Reserve will be awarded in each division. Points will be awarded as follows: 1st -10, 2nd - 6, 3rd- 4, 4th- 2, 5th- 1, 6th- .5. Champion- 10, Res. Champion -6. Point system will be in accordance with VHSA bonus point system.
17. High Point Trainer Award and High Point Owner Award are based on accrued points through the show series. Points to count are Champion (10) points and Res. Champion (6) points. ENTRANTS MUST LIST A TRAINER and OWNER ON THE ENTRY FORM AT EACH SHOW TO ACCRUE POINTS.
18. **In the event of inclement weather, a decision will be posted on the answering machine by 6:00am on the day of the show. Call the horse show office at 540-786-9124.**
19. Exhibitors show at their own risk. Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the judges or officials on the part of the owner, manager, rider or groom, shall disqualify the horse and the owner shall forfeit his entry and other fees.
20. Jumps in any or all classes are subject to change at the discretion of the Committee in the case of a jump off, accident to equipment or for any other reason deemed necessary.

21. The show committee reserves the right to refuse any entry, to change/combine/postpone/cancel or split classes/divisions or change officials.
22. Please use trash containers for disposal purposes. Leave only your hoof prints behind!
23. All guests and exhibitors will be held responsible for any damages they or their animals cause to show grounds and property.
24. Management/farm owner are not liable for injury to person or horse at anytime, which includes going to, coming from, and in the ring. Neither will it be responsible for vehicles or any article that may be lost or damaged.
25. Should any question or dispute arise that is not provided for in the foregoing rules, the same shall be submitted to the show management, whose decision shall be final.

Each barn or individual will be issued a packet with numbers, courses, and COVID-19 policy. Packets can be found on the porch outside of the office. Please have one representative pick up your barn's packet.

When you are done at the horse show, please place your check or exact change in the given packet and return the packet to the table on the porch outside of office in the "COMPLETED" bin. Please ensure that everyone's money from your barn is in the packet before dropping it off. Checks should be made out to Whitestone Farm Horse Show. If paying in cash, it needs to be exact change. No change will be given.

Courses will be posted on the Whitestone Farm Horse Shows Facebook page prior to the show and will be included in each barn/individual's packet.

Based on pre-entries, the numbers and times of schooling breaks will be determined by show management. Schooling breaks will be for the people in that division only, unless you ask permission. This information will be on Facebook by noon the day before the show. The jump heights will be set. Please do not change the jump heights.

No ribbons will be distributed at the ring. Please keep track of your awards. Ribbons will be on the porch outside the office for people to take as they leave.

No stall rentals available. The barns and wash stalls are closed to all exhibitors. A hose near the trailer parking field will be available for filling buckets and rinsing horses.

No dogs allowed.

We expect everyone on the premises to follow current CDC guidelines on all aspects of COVID-19.
