- Oakland Heights Farm horse show will be held at 17110 James Madison Highway, Gordonsville, VA 22942.
- The first class of each division, with the exception of Puddle Jumpers, will be scored under USEF Table II 2c- Power and Speed. (Classes 3, 5, 7, 9, 12, 14, 16.)
- The first class of Puddle Jumpers, Class 1, will be scored under USEF Table IV 2C- Power and Speed Optimum Time- or, Table IV1- Optimum Time First Round.
- The second class of each division will be scored under USEF Table II 1- Time 1st Round. (Classes 2, 4, 6, 8, 10, 13, 15, 17.)

Class Specifications:

Puddle Jumpers- Open to horses and ponies. May only cross enter into any class not exceeding 3'.

Novice Jumpers- Open to horses and ponies in their 1st or 2nd year of showing in jumper classes at 2'6" or higher as of December 1st of the current show year. Horses and ponies in this division may only cross enter into the Novice Children's/Adult Amateur Jumper if rider is eligible, Thoroughbred Jumper and Low Jumper or any other class that does not exceed 3'0" at the same show. May be combined with Novice Children's/Adult Amateur Jumpers

Novice Children's/Adult Amateur Jumpers- Open to horses and ponies ridden by Children and Adult Amateurs in their first or second year of showing in jumper classes at 2'6" or higher as of December 1st, 2018. May only cross enter into any other class not exceeding 3'. May be combined with Novice Jumper.

Low Jumpers- Open to horses and ponies. No restrictions on riders. May be combined with TB Jumper.

TB Jumpers- Open to registered TBs and horses eligible to be registered. No restrictions on riders. Can only be combined with Low Jumper.

Jr/ AA Equitation- To be shown over a course of at least 10 Fences with at least one combination, 4 oxers, and a minimum of 2 additional jumper style tests, which may include a Liverpool, narrow fence, rollback turn, fence at the end of the ring, option fence. To be offered at two heights- 2'6" and 3'- with spreads not to exceed height, with one set of awards. To be judged on hands, seat, guidance, control, and optimum time.

Children's/ Adult Amateur Jumpers- Open to horses and ponies ridden by Children and Adult Amateurs.

Schooling Jumpers- Open to horses and ponies. No restrictions on riders.

Modified Jumpers- Open to horses and ponies. No restrictions on riders.
