Hanover Heritage Equestrian Center Specifications

Lead Line - Open to riders age 7 & under by 12/01/21. Judged 50% Equitation, 50% Suitability of mount. Riders are not allowed to cross enter classes where they would be asked to trot. Points go to rider. (BHSA)

Pre-Short Stirrup Equitation – Open to riders 10 years and under as of 12/01/21. Riders may be asked to walk, trot & perform simple Equitation tasks. Riders not to cross enter into classes where could be asked to canter or jump. (BHSA)

Short Stirrup Equitation – Open to riders age 12 & under by 12/01/21. Jumps may not exceed 18" and trotting is allowed. Riders may not cross enter into classes where they jump more than 18". (BHSA)

Short Stirrup Hunter – Open to horses and ponies ridden by children age 12 and under by 12/01/21. Four fences at 18". No Rider may show more than two mounts. Riders and mounts may not cross enter into any other division except pleasure. (VHSA)

Cross Rails - Open to horses and ponies. For fences at 18". Course maybe trotted. Mounts can not cross enter into classes jumping more than 2' (TIP)

Student Equitation – Open to riders in their first or second year of showing over fences at 2' or higher as of 12/01/21. Jumps to be a min. of 2' and trotting is allowed. To be judged as an equitation division. Points go to the rider. Riders are limited to 2 years only, whether they compete over fences. (BHSA)

Pleasure Pony – Open to ponies ridden by juniors. To be judged on manners, suitability, soundness and way of going. (BHSA, VHSA)

Green Pony/Green Hunter – Open to ponies in their first year of showing at regulation heights ridden by juniors and horses in their first 2 years of showing over fences at or above 2'6" as of 12/01/21. Fences small 2', medium 2'3", large 2'6". May split if entries warrant. (BHSA, VHSA)

Pony Hunter – Open to ponies ridden by juniors. May be split small/medium and large if entries warrant. Fences small 2', medium 2'3", & large 2'6". (BHSA, VHSA)

BHSA/VHSA Pony Equitation – Open to juniors on ponies. Judged on hands, seat & control. ¼ of the class may return to the flat phase. Fences small 2', medium 2'3", and large 2'6". (BHSA, VHSA)

Equitation on the Flat – Open to Juniors and Adult Amateurs. May be split into Juniors 14 and under, Juniors 15-17, and Adult Amateur. May be combined if any or all sections have less than 3 entries. To be shown at walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring and judged on position, control and guidance. (BHSA, VHSA)

Pleasure Horse – Open to horses. (Hunter Tack required) To be judged on manners, suitability, soundness and way of going. To be split Junior/Adult if entries warrant. (BHSA, VHSA)

Maiden Hunter – Open to horses and ponies in their 1st year of showing over fences 2' and higher as of 12/01/21. No Restrictions on riders. Fences 2'. Courses may be trotted. (BHSA)

Low Hunter – Open to horses & ponies. No restrictions on riders. Fences 2' to 2'3". May be combined with Schooling Hunter if entries warrant. If combined, entries must jump the correct height for their division. (BHSA)

Limit Rider Hunter – Open to horses and ponies ridden by Junior/Adult Amateurs who are not entered in classes jumping 2'6" or higher. Riders are not eligible for AA Equitation, Pony Equitation, or Jr/Children's equitation. Ponies must be ridden by juniors. Horses and ponies may cross-enter into other divisions. Courses to be a min. of 6 fences at 2'3". (BHSA)

Thoroughbred Hunter – Open to all horses registered/eligible to register with the Jockey Club. Shown over fences at min. 2'6". Points awarded per show rating. May only be combined with Working Hunter and Green Hunter Divisions. (VHSA, BHSA)

Working Hunter – Open to horses not entered in pony division at same show. May be combined with Green Hunter horse Division and Thoroughbred Hunter Division. In order to accrue VHSA associate points the height shall be no lower than 2'6". (VHSA) Jump height must be no lower than 2'9" (BHSA).

Children's/Adult Amateur Hunter – Open to juniors on horses, & Adult Amateurs on horses or ponies not entered in a pony division. Fences 2'6". May be split if entries warrant. (BHSA, VHSA)

BHSA/VHSA Children's/Adult Amateur Equitation – Open to juniors & adult amateurs on horses. Judged on hands, seat & control. ¼ of the class may return for the flat phase. Fences 2'6" or 3'. (BHSA, VHSA)

All Shows are scheduled to be held in the outdoor arena, but in the event of bad weather, please check the website for last minute changes.

SHOW RULES

1. No dogs or alcoholic beverages allowed.
2. Classes are \$15.00 each for Hunter and \$25.00 each for Jumpers.
3. Negative coggins within last 12 months (copy required)
4. Proper tack attire is required for all classes; jackets may be excused by the judge.
5. ASTM approved helmets must be worn at all times while mounted.
6. Class Specification – Every class offered herein, which is covered by the rules and regulations of the current BHSA and VHSA rule book, will be conducted and judged accordingly. The judge's decision is always final.
7. There will be 6 ribbons given per class with Champion and Reserve Champion for every division. Points will be counted 10,6,4,2,1,.5, Champion 10, Reserve Champion 6. Point system is subject to change per VHSA/BHSA rule change.
8. All exhibitors must be checked in at the in-gate when their class is called.
9. Show management reserves the right to refuse entries, cancel and/or combine classes if necessary.
10. Exhibitors show at their own risk. A Limited Liability Waiver must be signed in order to participate.
11. Any rider/spectator may be asked to leave at any time for misconduct.
12. \$ 25.00 fee charged for all returned checks.
13. Limited day stalls are available for a fee of \$ 25.00 per day. Call ahead to Manager to reserve. Cancellations must be called in by 9:00 a.m. the Friday prior to horse show or you will be charged in full.
14. Participants and spectators alike understand that horses are inherently unpredictable and dangerous and that equipment and ground conditions are equally unpredictable; and knowingly choose to participate and/or spectate, taking full responsibility for this choice. Entry onto the grounds constitutes knowledge and agreement with this policy.

Judging Criteria:

- All Pleasure classes are judged on manners, suitability, soundness and way of going.
- All Hunter classes will be judged on performance; including way of going, jumping style and soundness. Manners and suitability will be emphasized in Pony, Children's and Adult Amateur classes.
- All Equitation classes will be judged on hands, seat, guidance and control.
- Year End Awards – Horse/Rider must compete in at least 5 shows to receive a year end award. Divisions must be held **four** times or it will be dropped from year end awards. Lead Line points will be combined as a division for Year End awards. Year End Division Champion and Reserve Ribbons to be presented at the last show and the exhibitor must be present to claim year end awards and ribbons.

Ties for year-end awards will be broken as follows:

1. Number of Champions received
2. Number of Reserve Champions received
3. Number of first place ribbons received
4. Number of shows attended
