


Show Rules

1. *This show is an Associate Member of VHSA and DCareHSA. Each VHSA class offered herin is covered by the rules and regulations of the VHSA rule book and will be conducted and judged accordingly.
2. Hard Hats must be worn at all times while mounted. Junior members must wear safety helmets with approved (USEF or USPC) harnesses.
3. Pre-registration is preferred. Available on the website, www.clarkecountyfair.org under Departments-Horses through Show Works. Deadline to preregister is July 31st. Gate admission will be charged to vehicle driver, rider, trainer, and parents but will receive a coupon which can be turned into the Horse Show Secretary's Office for reimbursement. This coupon does not include entry onto the Fair area itself except for the rider.
4. **All entries must bring a current negative (within 12 months) Coggin's test result for each horse/pony.**
 - a. For those horses/ponies residing in the Ruritan barn, a copy will remain with the Barn Supervisor during the week of the Fair.
 - b. For those horses/ponies being shown, this must be shown before a back number is given.
5. It is highly recommended that all horse/ponies attending shows at the Fairgrounds be current with the following immunizations: Eastern and Western Encephalomyelitis, West Nile Virus, Tetanus, Flu and Rhino. **THESE IMMUNIZATIONS ARE MANDATORY THIS YEAR FOR ALL HORSES/PONIES STAYING IN THE RURITAN HORSE BARN.**
6. Management reserves the right to determine that unruly animals or animals treated cruelly be removed from the Fairgrounds.
7. Hard hats must be worn at all times when a rider is mounted.
8. All entry fees must be paid in cash or with good check the day of the show.
9. Management reserves the right to cancel, combine, or split classes if necessary.
10. Judge's decision is final.
11. Horse Show Committee and the Clarke County Ruritan Club are not responsible for any accident to rider, animal, property, or equipment that may occur on the grounds.

Divisions

Champion and Reserve Ribbons in all Divisions that hold three classes. 6 Ribbons/Class.

Warm Up in Ring 7:15-7:45 a.m.

LEAD LINE

Open to Riders 7 years and Younger.

1. Lead Line (100% Pony)
2. Lead Line (100% Rider Equitation)
3. Lead Line (50% Pony, 50% Rider Equitation)

PRE-SHORT STIRRUP

Open to Riders 10 and Younger; riders may not cross-enter into any classes that canter.

4. Pre-Short – Walk
5. Pre-Short – Walk/Trot
6. Pre-Short – Walk/Trot with 2 point position

SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION

Open to Riders 12 and Younger; may only cross-enter in short stirrup, hunter, pleasure, and trail.

7. Short Stirrup – Walk
8. Short Stirrup – Walk/Trot/Individual Canter
9. Short Stirrup – Walk/Trot/Trot or Canter 2 cross rails

*VHSA ASSOCIATE HUNTER SHORT STIRRUP

Open to Riders 12 and Under. May not jump high than 2' at this show.

10. *Short Stirrup Under Saddle
11. *Short Stirrup Over Fences – Jumps at 18"
12. *Short Stirrup Over Fences – Jumps at 18"

TRAIL CLASSES

Available at 10:00 a.m.; Held outside of the Ring.

13. In-Hand
14. Mounted

Purpose of this class is to show a good relationship between horse and rider. Entries may practice the obstacles before competing. Riders may enter as often as they wish, but must change mounts; entry fee/entry. Horses/ponies may be entered more than once, but with a different rider; entry fee/entry.

Winner of this class will receive a trophy awarded by the Clarke County Equine Alliance

SCHOOLING/LOW HUNTER

15. Low Hunter Under Saddle
16. Low Hunter Over Fences – Jumps at 2'
17. Low Hunter Over Fences – Jumps at 2'

*VHSA ASSOCIATE HUNTER PLEASURE PONY

Open to Junior Riders Only.

18. *Pleasure Pony – Walk/Trot
19. *Pleasure Pony – Go As You Please
20. *Pleasure Pony – Walk/Trot/Canter
21. *Clarke County Pleasure Pony – *Open to residents of Clarke County ONLY.*

Walk/Trot/Canter both ways of the ring and may be asked to back or other test.

Winner is awarded the Ann Clay Memorial Perpetual Trophy and will keep a trophy donated by the Clarke County Ruritan Club.

*VHSA ASSOCIATE GREEN PONY HUNTER

Open to Ponies in their first year of showing; to be ridden by Junior Riders Only.

23. *Green Pony Hunter Over Fences – Small 2', Medium 2'3", Large 2'6"
24. *Green Pony Hunter Over Fences – Small 2', Medium 2'3", Large 2'6"

*VHSA ASSOCIATE PONY HUNTER

Open to all Ponies ridden by Juniors.

25. *Pony Hunter Under Saddle
26. *Pony Hunter Over Fences – Small 2', Medium 2'3", Large 2'6"
27. *Pony Hunter Over Fences – Small 2', Medium 2'3", Large 2'6"
Large Pony Champion receives the "Uncle Jack" Perpetual Trophy and will keep a trophy donated by the Clarke County Ruritan Club.

*VHSA PONY EQUITATION OVER FENCES

28. *Small 2', Medium 2'3", Large 2'6"

Horse to be judged at walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring. May be asked to back or other test requested by the judge.
Winner of this class is awarded the Perpetual Trophy donated by the Lewis M. Allen Riding Club and will keep a trophy donated by the Clarke County Riding Club.

*VHSA ASSOCIATE GREEN HUNTER

Open to all horses showing in their first or second year.

May be combined with Green Pony Hunter
