TURNER FARM RULES AND REGULATIONS

Office Fee: A \$20.00 Office Fee will be charged per horse/pony.

Class Specifications: Every class labeled VHSA will be conducted and judged according to the current VHSA Rule Book. The Judge's decisions are always final. Leadline -7 and under, Pre-Short -9 and under, Short Stirrup 12 and under, Beginner Equitation -first or second year of showing.

Cross Entering: Leadline may enter Pre-Short Walk, Pre-Short rider may not canter or jump. Beginner Equitation and Short Stirrup may not jump over 18"

Entry Fees: \$15.00 per class, including Warm-up

Schooling: Schooling permitted in show rings from 6:30 am - 8:30 am.

Coggins Test: All exhibitors must present a **hard copy** Negative Coggins Test report taken within one year on each animal exhibited. Electronic copies not excepted.

Responsibilities: Horse show staff, volunteers, Turner Farm Events, Turner Farm Park and Fairfax County Park Service, their officials and employees will not be responsible for any accident, or loss, which may occur to any exhibitor, spectator, rider, guest, groom attendant, or other employee, animal or equipment at the show. The show reserves the right to decline or accept any entry and return any entry fees before or during the show without being liable for compensation; to change the location, combine, cancel, split or limit any classes; or change any officials.

Dogs: All Dogs must be on leashes while on the show grounds.

Awards: Six ribbons per class.
Champion and Reserve points scored 10, 6, 4, 2, 1, 0.5

POINTS

Turner Farm will host a Year End Banquet to award the high point horses/ponies/riders for the show year. Ties will be broken based on number of shows attended.

DIRECTIONS

Turner Farm is located at the intersection of Georgetown Pike (Route 193) and Springvale Road (Route 674) in Great Falls, Virginia. The horse show entrance is on Springvale Road

Open to horses and ponies judged on performance, manners, way of going, suitability and soundness. Fences 2'3", 2'6"

VHSA Working Hunter - *Sponsored by Elizabeth Kovalak*

Open to horses and to ponies not entered in pony divisions at same show. Fences 2'9", 3'

VHSA Children's/Adult Amateur Hunter - *Sponsored by Madeira School*

Open to Junior and Adult Amateur riders on horses. Fences 2'6", 2'9"

VHSA Junior /Adult Equitation

Open to Juniors and Adults on horses. Judged on position, control, and guidance. Fences 2'6", 2'9"

VHSA Pony Hunter - *Sponsored by Rokeby Farm Stables*

Open to ponies 14.2 and under ridden by Juniors. Small 2', Medium 2'3", Large 2'6"

Turner Farm Equitation - *Sponsored by Car Spa Dealer Services*

Judged on position, control, and guidance. Fences 2'

Low Hunter - *Sponsored by Karen Washburn at Long & Foster*

Open to horses and ponies judged on performance, manners, way of going, suitability and soundness. Fences 2'

Turner Hopeful - *Sponsored by Dominion Wine & Beer*

Open to beginners in Ring 1, on horses or ponies, riders of all ages. Fences 18"

Lead Line - *Sponsored by Frick Horse Transportation*

Riders 7 and under. Rider not eligible for any other classes that they would be asked to trot.

To be judged on ride's equitation and pony's suitability and manners as a leadline mount.

Pre-Short Stirrup - *Sponsored by Law Office of Charles B. Molster III*

Riders 9 and under. May not cross enter into classes where asked to canter or jump.

Short Stirrup Equitation - *Sponsored by WIHS*

Riders 12 and under. May not enter any classes with fences over 18".

VHSA Short Stirrup - *Heritage Farm & Elizabeth Gregg*

Open to riders 12 years and under. May not jump higher than 2' at this show. Short stirrup riders, ponies, horses may not cross enter into any VHSA Associate division except Pleasure Pony or Pleasure Horse.

Beginner Equitation - *Sponsored by Stoneridge Farm*

Rider must be in their first or second year of showing.

VHSA Horse Pleasure - *Sponsored by The Board Hound*

Open to horses ridden by juniors or adults. To be judged on manners, suitability, soundness, way of going.

VHSA Pony Pleasure

Open to all ponies ridden by juniors. To be judged on manners, suitability, soundness, way of going.
