**RING 1 – 9:00 am start**

1 – Warm Up – all day before each hunter division

2, 3, 4 – Schooling / Baby Green Hunter (Open to all riders. Fences 2ft or 2'6")

5, 6, 7 – Working Hunter\* (Open to horses & ponies not entered in a Pony Hunter Division. Fences 2'6" or 3ft May be combined with Thoroughbred or Green Hunter in order to fill.)

8, 9, 10 – Green Hunter\* (Open to horses in their 1st or 2nd year of showing over fences)

11, 12, 13 – Pony Hunter / Green Pony Hunter\* (Open to ponies 14.2 & under ridden by junior riders only. Fences Sm 2'/Med 2'3"/ Large 2'6".)

14 – VHSA Associate Pony Equitation Over Fences\* (Open to junior riders on ponies 14.2 hands & under to be shown over fences Sm 2'/Med 2'3"/ Large 2'6".)

15, 16, 17– Amateur Adult Hunter\* (Open to Adult Amateur riders on horses and ponies not ridden in a pony division. Fences 2'6" or 3' May combine with Children's/Juniors to fill.)

18 – VHSA Associate Junior Equitation on the Flat 14 & Under\* (will combine with and 15-17 if needed)

19 – VHSA Associate Junior Equitation on the Flat 15-17\* (will combine with and 14 & Under if needed)

20 – VHSA Associate Adult Equitation on the Flat\*

21 – VHSA Associate Adult / Junior Equitation Over Fences\* (Open to Junior and Adult Amateur riders on horses only. Fences 2'6" or 3ft. May split if 3 of each.)

22, 23, 24 – Children's / Junior Hunter\* (Open to Junior riders on horses and ponies not ridden in a pony division. Fences 2'6" or 3ft. May combine with Amateur Adults to fill.)

25, 26, 27 – Special Hunter (Open to horses & ponies ridden by Junior or Amateur riders. Fences 2ft or 2'6")

28, 29, 30 – Pleasure Pony\* (Open to Ponies 14.2 hands & under in hunter tack to be ridden by junior riders only.)

31, 32, 33 – Pleasure Horse Junior / Adult\* (Open to all horses in hunter tack ridden by Adults or Juniors Will split if needed.)

34 – Musical Freestyle (Open to horse or Pony: bring own music on cell phone, 1 min. in ring to make up your own course (do not have to jump), can be ridden or done on foot.)

35 – Novice Jumpers 2'6"\*

36, 37, 38 – Open Jumpers 3'3"\*

**RING 2 – will not start before noon**

39, 40, 41 – 4 x's and lead changes don't count (Open to all riders. No restriction on horse or pony. Simple changes allowed.)

42, 43, 44– VHSA Short Stirrup Hunter\* (4 x's) (Open to riders 12 & under. Fences at 18")

45, 46, 47 – Long/Short Stirrup Equitation (4 x's) (Open to all riders. Fences at 18".)

48, 49, 50 – Very Beginner Pleasure – Walk / Trot – open to all ages

51, 52, 53 – Walk / Trot Equitation – (Open to all ages.)

54 – Leadline (To be led at the walk. Judged 50/50 rider/suitability of mount.)

55 – Leadline with questions from the Judge (To be led at the walk. Judged 50/50 rider/suitability of mount)

56, 57, 58– Walk Only (no leader) – both directions

59, 60, 61– Pole Course – Walk Only

62, 63, 64 – Pole Course – Walk / Trot

65, 66, 67 – Walk / Trot – what are diagonals?

68, 69, 70 – Baby Green Horse / Pony – Walk / Trot (Open to all riders on horses or ponies.)

71, 72 – Handy Hunter Over Poles – Walk Only

73, 74 – Handy Hunter Over Poles – Walk / Trot – open to all

\* denotes a VHSA Associate rated division

75 – Pairs Class – Walk Only

76 – Pairs Class – Walk / Trot

77, 78, 79 – Puddle Jumpers (Ground Pole or 2ft) (Open to horses and ponies. Adults may ride a pony.)

80 – Cloverleaf Cones (W/T/C) – timed pattern class (Open to all riders, horses & ponies)

81 – Quad Cones (W/T/C) – timed pattern class (Open to all riders, horses & ponies)

82 – Straight Cones (W/T/C) – timed pattern class (Open to all riders, horses & ponies)

83 – Bleeding Heart (W/T/C) – timed pattern class (Open to all riders, horses & ponies)

### **Rules & General Information**

1. Six ribbons will be awarded in all classes.
2. Championship & Reserve ribbons will be awarded in each division.
3. Classes are \$15 each. Stalls \$30.
4. **EVERYONE MUST WEAR A HELMET WHEN MOUNTED.**
5. The judge's decision is final.
6. All dogs must be on a leash at all times.
7. After 3 refusals, exhibitor is required to exit the ring.
8. Entries must be paid at time of entry.
9. **CURRENT NEGATIVE COGGINS REQUIRED.**

**Conditions of Entry** – Participants realize and accept the inherent risks, injuries, and death due to equine activities.

Every horse entered for competition will be under the control of the Show Management, but Management will in no case be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the Show Management and the facility harmless for any loss or accident to his or her horse, horses, or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire, or otherwise. Management reserves the right to interpret all questions and conditions regarding or arising out of an incident at the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions not covered in these rules and regulations shall be decided by Management, and their decision is final. Discourtesy to an official or show staff by any spectator, rider, trainer, or groom will disqualify the horse or horses with which they are associated, and all fees will be forfeited.
