*VHSA Associate Classes

Hunter Division Class Specifications

VHSA short stirrup: Open to Junior riders who have not reached their 13th birthday by 12/1/2023. Judged as a Hunter division. Riders may cross enter into pleasure only. Fences 18'. Short Stirrup riders, ponies and horses may not cross enter into any other VHSA Associate Division or a VHSA Associate Rated Equitation Class except VHSA Associate Junior Equitation on the Flat and Pleasure Pony or Pleasure Horse.

Junior Hunter Pleasure Horse: Open to Junior riders. No crossentering between this and adult Hunter pleasure at the same show.

Senior Pleasure: Open to non Junior riders. No cross entering between this and Junior Hunter pleasure at the same show.

Junior Hunter and Adult Hunter Pleasure Horse - This Division may be combined if needed. It is up to the Show Secretary to specify by each animal whether they are a Junior or Adult. Horses may cross enter into another VHSA Associate Pleasure Division at the same show. An Amateur Adult or Professional may enter the Adult Hunter Pleasure Horse Division.

Children's Hunter - This Division may only be combined with the Adult Amateur Division. If the Division is combined with Children's Hunter, it is up to the Show Secretary to specify by each animal whether they are a Children's Hunter or Adult Amateur Hunter.

Adult Amateur Hunter - This Division may only be combined with the Children's Hunter Division. If the Division is combined with Children's Hunter, it is up to the Show Secretary to specify by each animal whether they are a Children's Hunter or Adult Amateur Hunter.

VHSA Adult Equitation on the flat: Open to non professional riders 18 years of age and older.

VHSA Equitation on the flat 14 and under: Open to riders who have not reached their 15 birthday by December 1st.

VHSA Equitation on the flat 15-17: Open to riders who have reached their 15th birthday by December 1st of the calendar year but have not reached their 18th birthday by December 1st.

Novice Children's/Adult Amateur Jumper - Open to children and adult amateurs in their 1st or 2nd year of showing in jumper classes at 2'6" or higher as of December 1st of the current show year. Riders in this division may only cross enter into the Novice Jumper if horse is eligible, Thoroughbred Jumper and Low Jumper or any other class that does not exceed 3'0" at the same show. Associations may submit points for their jumper divisions that have the same specifications as VHSA Associate Jumper Divisions. However, shows must use the VHSA Division names on their result sheets.

Novice Children's/Adult Amateur Jumper and Novice Jumper classes may be run together, with separate points reported to the Associate Program.

Novice Jumper - Open to horses and ponies in their 1st or 2nd year of showing in jumper classes at 2'6" or higher as of December 1st of the current show year. Horses and ponies in this division may only cross enter into the Novice Children's/Adult Amateur Jumper if rider is eligible, Thoroughbred Jumper and Low Jumper or any other class that does not exceed 3'0" at the same show. Associations may submit points for their jumper divisions that have the same specifications as VHSA Associate Jumper Divisions. However, shows must use the VHSA Division names on their result sheets.

Special Hunter: Open to horse and ponies. Open to all riders and horse/pony combinations. Fences are 2' and 2'6". The two heights are judges together. Both heights to be judged together.

Children's Hunter: Fences 2'9-3'0". Riders may cross enter into pleasure but not into any regular horse division. Both heights to be judged together.

Adult Amateur Hunter: Fences 2'9-3'0". Riders may cross enter into pleasure but not into any regular Hunter division. Both heights to be judged together.

Entry Fees & Requirements

- \$40 per hunter class, \$100 per division;
- \$45 per equitation class;
- \$35 per jumper class;
- \$35 per entry or supporting documentation received after Thursday before the show.

VHSA rules and division specifications apply.

VHSA Points will be awarded to current members only. Membership Forms are available from the show secretary.

Show manager reserves the right to combine or cancel classes if there are insufficient entries.

Entries must be submitted electronically through Strider Pro. Contact show secretary for special situations.

Points for Champion/Reserve will use VHSA rules:

Show Management Rules

- All riders must wear ASTM/SEI approved helmets while mounted.
- A Beverly Release must be signed by each rider/exhibitor (and his or her parent or legal guardian if under the age of 18) and other related participants prior to participating in any activity or riding at Beverly.
- Current negative Coggins on all horses on the show grounds must be presented to show secretary.
- 4. Payment must be left with show secretary in office before numbers are given out.
- Show Management reserves the right to refuse entries before or during the show without liability or compensation.
- 6. Show Management will not tolerate hostile or unsportsmanlike behavior.
- Items left on show grounds will be kept for a limited time before given away or thrown out. Please be sure to get all personal items before leaving shows.
- 8. All riders/exhibitors (including parents and legal guardians if under the age of 18), owners, trainers, their agents, and other related Participants will be held responsible for any damage to the Show grounds, jumps, rails/poles, and/or Beverly property.

- 9. No one or horse is allowed to walk the grounds outside of the show area. No one is allowed to touch resident horses or use their items or inside wash stalls.
- 10. All classes can be moved, canceled, split or combined at the option of Show Management.
- 11. Anyone disqualified may be found ineligible for ribbons or prizes.
- 12. Ribbons or prizes must be picked up at show office on show days or by appointment.
- 13. NO CROSS COUNTRY SCHOOLING

The management is not liable for any injury to person or horse at any time.
