Directions to Whippoorwill Farm:

From Richmond - take I-64 East to Exit 220 toward West Point. Go approximately 13 miles and turn left on to Centerville Rd. (across from Nick's Restaurant) Turn right on to Clancie Rd. The show grounds will be on your left. **Continue past the farm entrance and turn left on to Bugan Villa Lane.**

From Williamsburg – take I-64 West to Exit 220 toward West Point. Go approximately 13 miles and turn left on to Centerville Rd. (across from Nick's Restaurant) Turn right on to Clancie Rd. The show grounds will be on your left.

From Route 17 – Take VA-33 West in Glenss. Turn right onto Centerville Rd. (across from Nick's Restaurant) Turn right on to Clancie Rd. The show grounds will be on your left.

Rules and Regulations:

1. All shows are Associate members of VHSA.
2. Six ribbons will be awarded in all classes. Division champions & reserve champions receive a ribbon. Classes with fewer than six entries may be combined at management's discretion.
3. Hard hats are required at all times when mounted. **All riders must wear an approved helmet at all times.**
4. A horse/ pony must have been entered in at least one class over fences in a division to be eligible for the under saddle class and must be in the top 4 over fences to be eligible for the Champion or Reserve Champion.
5. **A Negative Coggins is required for all animals on the grounds and a copy must be provided to show secretary.**
6. This show is run in accordance with the ground rules of the VHSA, with the exception of fence heights.
7. Any talking to the judge is prohibited. The judge's placing is final.
8. Whippoorwill Farm reserves the right to refuse any entry; to change the time schedule; to combine classes; or to change judges at any time.
9. The one-minute rule may be enforced for entering the ring.
10. A rider's age is defined by their age as of December 1, 2017.
11. Whippoorwill Farm will not be responsible for accidents or loss of property.
12. All dogs must be leashed.
13. No stallions permitted on grounds.
14. All riding is done at your own risk according to VA Equine law & all persons on the property are considered participants or spectators
15. A \$25 fee will be charged for returned checks.

Division Specifications:

Children's/Adult Am. Hunter: Open to children or adult amateurs on horses; fences 2'6" or 3'. Riders may not cross enter into any regular horse division. Will be split if entries warrant.

Children's/Adult Equitation: Open to children or adult amateur on horses; fences 2'6" or 3'. Riders may not cross enter into any other equitation classes except VHSA Equitation on the Flat and Non-Recognized Children's or Adult Medal.

Open/Working: Open to horses only; fences 2'6" or 3'.

VHSA Equitation on the Flat: To be shown at a W/T/C, both ways of the ring and judged on position, control and guidance. Tests 1-19 may be used, excluding those requiring work over fences. Class will be split into Junior Equitation on the Flat 15-17, Junior Equitation on the Flat 14 & under and Adult Amateur Equitation on the Flat.

VHSA Associate Thoroughbred Hunter: Limited to horses that are registered with or who are eligible to be registered with the Jockey Club; fences 2'6", 2'9", or 3'.

Green Pony Hunter: Open to ponies of any age in their first year of showing in any classes that require ponies to jump the designated height for green ponies. Smalls jump 2', Mediums jump 2', and Larges jump 2'3".

Pony Hunter: Open to junior riders on ponies. Smalls jump 2', Mediums jump 2'3" and Larges jump 2'6".

Pony Equitation: Open to junior riders on ponies. Riders may not cross enter into any other equitation classes except VHSA Equitation on the flat and non-recognized Medal class. Smalls jump 2', Mediums jump 2'3" and Larges jump 2'6".

Pleasure Pony: Open to junior riders on ponies. Riders will be asked to walk, trot, canter and show their mount at the judge's discretion.

Junior Hunter Pleasure Horse: Open to junior riders horses shown with hunter tack on the flat. Riders will be asked to walk, trot, canter and show their mount at the judge's discretion. May be combined with Adult and/or Pony Pleasure.

Adult Hunter Pleasure Horse: Open to adult riders on horses shown with hunter tack on the flat. Will be asked to walk, trot, canter and show their mount at the judge's discretion. May be combined with Adult and/or Pony Pleasure.

Pre-Beginner Equitation: Open to riders who have not yet shown at the canter. 12" Crossrail trot only course. Flat class is walk-trot. Riders may cross enter into walk-trot divisions only.

Short Stirrup Hunter: Open to horses and ponies ridden by junior riders age 12 and under as of December 1, 2017. Fences 18". Riders and horses cannot cross enter into class where they jump more than 18".

Beginner Equitation: Open to all riders in their first year of showing over fences greater than cross-rails. Riders may cross enter in to Pleasure Divisions, & Short Stirrup as eligible.

Baby Green Pleasure: Limited to horses in their first or second year of showing at any horse show.

Modified Pleasure: open to all horses & ponies with no restrictions.

Baby Green Hunter: Limited to horses/ponies in their first or second year of showing over fences at any horse show.

Green Hunter: Limited to horses in their first or second year of showing at 2'6". First year horses jump 2'6" and second year horses jump 3'.

Walk-Trot: Open to riders who have not yet shown at the canter

Walk and Trainer Assisted Trot: Riders will be asked to walk, two-point, briefly trot, and trot a pole. Trainers may stay in the ring and assist with the trot as needed.

Special Hunter: Open to horse and ponies. Trotting and simple lead changes are permitted. Fences 2' or 2'6".
