## **Hunter Division Specifications**

**Lead Line** - Open to Juniors, escorted by a lead. Judged on rider's turnout and position. Riders may not cross enter.

**Pre-Short Stirrup** - Open to Juniors 11 and under. May not cross enter into any class that canters or jumps.

**VHSA Short Stirrup Hunter**- Open to Juniors that have not reached their 13th birthday as of Dec 1st, 2023. Riders may not cross enter into any class over 18". Four to six fences. Riders may not cross enter into Long Stirrup

**VHSA Pleasure Pony** - Open to Junior on ponies only. Judged on manners and way of going.

**Novice Equitation**- Open to Juniors and Amateurs only. Course of 4-8 jumps as cross rails. Trotting changes are permissible. Riders cannot cross enter into any over fences class over 18".

**Open Equitation** - Open to juniors or amateurs and judged on equitation. Riders may be called in for a flat test. Trotting changes are permitted. May not cross enter into any VHSA over fences equitation class. Six to eight fences.

**Special Hunter** - Open to all. Six to eight fences. Judged as a hunter class.

**VHSA Pony Hunter** - Open to Juniors only. 2' (sm), 2'3" (med), 2'6" (lg). Six to eight fences.

**VHSA Pony Equitation** - Open to Juniors only. Judged on hands, seat, and control. Six to eight fences.

**VHSA Equitation on the Flat Adult** - Open to amateurs 18 years of age and older. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring and judged on position, control and guidance. Tests 1-19 may be used, excluding those requiring work over fences. Three entries are necessary to fill this class. If there are insufficient entries, this class may be combined with the Junior Equitation on the Flat 15-17 and/or the Junior Equitation on the Flat 14 & Under.

**VHSA Pleasure Horse Junior** Open to horses shown with hunter tack on the flat, ridden by a Junior. It is acceptable for Associate Horse Shows to combine the Adult Hunter Pleasure and the Junior Pleasure Hunter Divisions,

**VHSA Pleasure Horse Adult** Open to horses shown with hunter tack on the flat, ridden by an Adult. It is acceptable for Associate Horse Shows to combine the Adult Hunter Pleasure and the Junior Pleasure Hunter Divisions,

**VHSA Pleasure Pony** Open to ponies ridden by a Junior. The Hunter Pleasure Pony Division may only be combined with the Adult Hunter Pleasure Horse and/or the Junior Hunter Pleasure Division. **Long Stirrup Hunter** - Open to juniors or amateurs. Trotting and trotting changes are permissible. Riders may not cross enter into any class over 18". Four fences.

**Baby Green Hunter** - Open to ponies and horses in their first or second year of showing. Four to six fences. Trotting changes are permissible. Animals may not cross enter over 2'

**BHSA Maiden Hunter** Open to horses and ponies in their first year of showing over fences at 2' or higher as of December 1 of the current show year. No restrictions on riders. Jump heights to be a minimum of 2'. Courses may be trotted if specified in the Prize List. A horse/pony's Maiden status is not affected if the horse/pony has not been shown at more than four (4) competitions prior to September 1st and if it was not shown at that height after September 1st in the same year. (Provided) in order to maintain Maiden status for the next competition year the horse/pony must be withdrawn from competition over regulation height and the owner must notify the BHSA by letter, via certified/return receipt mail, or email prior to December 1 of the year of withdrawal. The horse/pony's name and recording number must be included in the letter. May be combined with Low Hunter and/or Limit Rider Hunter. To be judged on performance including way of going, style of jumping, and soundness.

**BHSA Student Equitation** Open to riders in their first or second year of showing over fences at 2' or higher as of December 1 of the current show year. Jumps to be a minimum of 2'. Riders competing in the Student Equitation Division are limited to two years only, whether they compete over fences or not. To be judged as an equitation division. Points go to the rider. Courses may be trotted. To be judged on hands, seat, guidance, and control throughout the class.

**VHSA Working Hunter** - Open to horses. Six to eight fences at 2'6 or 2'9.

**VHSA Child/Adult Hunter** - Open to Juniors and Adult Amateurs. Will split if entries warrant. Six to eight fences at 2'6 or 2'9.

**VHSA Child/Adult Equitation** - Open to Juniors and Adult Amateurs. Will split if entries warrant. Judged on hands, seat, and control. Six to eight fences at 2'6 or 2'9.

**VHSA Green Pony/Horse Hunter** - Open to ponies in their first year and horses in their first or second year year of showing at or above designated height. Adults must ride horses. Ponies must be ridden by Juniors. 2' (sm), 2'3" (med), 2'6" (lg and horses). To be split into Pony and Horse divisions if entries warrant. Six to eight fences.

**VHSA Thoroughbred Hunter** - Open to horses registered with or eligible to be registered with the Jockey Club. Six to eight fences at 2'6 or 2'9.

**JR/Am Derby**- Open to juniors or amateurs on horses or ponies.

**Open Derby**- Open to all horse/rider combinations.

One derby entry per rider/horse combination. Numerical scoring.

## **Jumper Division Specifications**

*Except for Tadpoles, the first class of all other jumper divisions will be scored under USEF Table II, Section 2(b) Time first jump-off. . The second class of all other jumper divisions will be scored under USEF Table II 1- Time 1st Round. In Crossrails the first class will be USEF Table IV1 – Optimum Time. The second class will be USEF Table II, Section 2(b) – Time first jump-off.*

**Tadpoles** - Open to juniors and amateurs only. Course of ground poles. Scored under USEF Table IV1- Optimum Time First Round.

**Crossrails**- Open to junior and amateurs only. Cross rails not to exceed 18’.

**Pre-Novice Horse Jumper** — Open to horses and ponies, riders in this division may only cross enter into any class lower than 3’ if otherwise eligible. Fence height should not be lower than 2’ or greater than 2’3”. Showing in this division does not break Novice status.

**Pre-Novice Child/Adult Jumper** — Open to juniors and amateurs, riders in this division may only cross enter into any class lower than 3’ if otherwise eligible. Fence height should not be lower than 2’ or greater than 2’3”. Showing in this division does not break Novice status.

**Open Jumper**- Open to all.

**Novice Jumper**: Open to horses and ponies in their 1st or 2nd year of showing in Jumper classes at 2’6” or higher as of Dec. 1st of the current show year. Horses and ponies in this division may only cross enter into classes not exceeding 3’.

**Novice Children’s/Adult Amateur Jumper**: Open to horses and ponies ridden by juniors and adult amateurs in their 1st or 2nd year of showing in Jumper classes at 2’6” or higher as of Dec. 1st of the current show year. Riders may cross-enter into classes not exceeding 3’.

**Low Jumper**: Open to horses and ponies. No restrictions on riders. May be combined with TB Jumper.

**Thoroughbred Jumper**: Open to registered Thoroughbreds and those eligible to be registered.

**Junior/Adult Amateur Jumper Equitation**: Open to juniors and adult amateurs. Judged on hands, seat, guidance, control and optimum time. Numerical scoring.

**Children’s/Adult Amateur Jumper**: Open to horses and ponies ridden by juniors and adult amateur riders.

**Schooling, Modified Jumpers**: No restriction on horses/ponies or riders.

\*\* Junior riders are those who have not reached their 18th birthday as of Dec 1st of the current show year.\*\*

**Best Turned Out Horse and Pony:** Strut your stuff! A best turned out horse and pony will be selected by the judge at each show. The winner will receive a prize and bragging rights.

**Sportsmanship Award:** HSCV wants to recognize riders that display excellent sportsmanship at the show. Sportsmanship is defined as fair and generous behavior or treatment of others, especially in a sports contest. Award winners showing sportsmanship towards their teammates, coaches, other participants, and/or their equine partner can be nominated.

A Handy Hunter class tests skills you and your horse might use during an enjoyable day of foxhunting: short turns, a brisk pace, trot jumps, galloping, dismounting and leading over an obstacle, even opening and shutting a gate from the saddle. Since the hunter jumper sport was developed on fox hunting principles, HSCV wishes to give riders of all levels the opportunity to participate in a handy course.
