RULES

1. Sanctioned by Equine Sports Council. No drug testing except for animal welfare.
2. VHSA Associate Rules apply.
3. Divisions recognized by VHSA Associate program are indicated with an * in class list.
4. All dogs must be on leash at all times.
5. Judge's decisions are final.
6. All exhibitors must wear ASTM/SEI protective helmets with harness fastened at all times while mounted on the show grounds. Proper attire is requested.
7. Entries will not be accepted without a signed entry form release.
8. In hunter divisions, points to be counted as follows:

9. Hunter classes must have a minimum of 3 to complete the course. The number of exhibitors for the Division will be determined by the number of horses or ponies shown successfully (completed the course) in the first performance (over fences) class of all Hunter Divisions and the number of horses or ponies shown in the first class of the Hunter Pleasure Divisions.
10. Exhibitors show at their own risk.
11. Food will be available on grounds.
12. All exhibitors must present a current negative Coggins Test .
13. Participants and spectators alike understand that horses are inherently unpredictable and dangerous and that equipment and ground conditions are equally unpredictable; yet knowingly choose to participate and/or spectate, taking responsibility for this choice. Entry onto the grounds constitutes knowledge and agreement with this policy.
14. ESC Show Commission: Chanda Boylen, Tamara Tucker, Teresa Seay
15. Stalls available for \$55.00. Shavings must be purchased from show. Hay available. Shavings \$10.00/bag and hay \$14.00/bale plus sales tax.
16. Grounds fee of \$35.00 for all horses without stalls.
17. All medical waste must be disposed of in designated receptacles.
18. Office/ESC fee \$45.00 for online entries and \$55.00 for in-office entries.
19. Online, early entries encouraged and appreciated. Payment by check or cash only. A blank check must be submitted to office in order to pick up back number.
20. Prize money credited to show bill. If additional money owed, a check will be mailed within 30 days.

VHSA ASSOCIATE CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

Pony Hunter Division

Open to ponies ridden by juniors. Ponies shown in this division may not be shown by an adult in any recognized division at the same horse show. Judged on performance, manners, and way of going. Small ponies (not to exceed 12.2h) to jump 2', medium ponies (over 12.2h - not to exceed 13.2h) to jump 2'3" and large ponies (over 13.2h - not to exceed 14.2h) to jump 2'6". Divisions must be offered split, but if there are not three ponies in either the Small/Medium or Large Pony divisions, the divisions must be combined. Lines less than 72' must be set on appropriate distances.

Children's/Adult Hunter Division

Open to juniors or adult amateurs mounted on horses. To be judged on performance, manners, and way of going. Fences 2'6 or 3'.

Working Hunter

Open to horses. To be judged on performance, manners, and way of going. Classes may be offered with height options but fences may not be lower than 3'0" or 3'3".

Green Hunter Horse

A green horse is a horse of any age in his first or second year of showing in any classes that require horses to jump the designated height for green horses. Fence height 2'6".

Green Hunter Pony

A Green Pony is a pony of any age in his first year of showing in any classes that require ponies to jump the designated height for green pony. (Ponies are only allowed to show one year as Green Ponies). Fence Height Small 2', Medium 2'3", Large 2'6". Ponies must be ridden by Juniors.

Pleasure Horse

Open to horses shown with hunter tack on the flat w/t, w/t/c and go as you please.

Pleasure Pony

Open to ponies shown with hunter tack on the flat w/t, w/t/c and go as you please.

Short Stirrup Hunter

Open to riders under age 12 on horses or ponies. Jumps 18"-2'.

NON-VHSA CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

Schooling Hunter

Open to horses and ponies ridden by juniors, amateurs, or professionals. To be judged on performance, manners, and way of going. Fences 2', 2'3" or 2'6".

Training Hunter

Open to horses and ponies ridden by juniors, amateurs, or professionals. To be judged on performance, manners, and way of going. Fences 2' or 2'3".

Short Stirrup Equitation

Open to riders under age 12 on horses or ponies. Jumps 18"-2'.

Newmarket Equitation

Open to amateurs and juniors on horses or ponies. Jumps 2'3", 2'6" or 3'.

Newmarket Hunter Derby

Open to horses and ponies ridden by juniors, amateurs, or professionals. 2'3", 2'6" or 3" with high options. Minimum of five entries for prize money to be awarded.

Field Hunter

Open to horses and ponies who have participated in at least one foxhunt with an MFHA Hunt in the last 5 years. To be judged on suitability for a traditional field hunter. Field Hunter Hack at 2'3" and Field Hunter O/F at 2'3"-2'6".

Jumper Classes according to standard Table II formats as set forth in the Class List. Points for towards High Point Series Awards counted as follows: 10, 6, 4, 2, 1, .5 with double points for Classics. Minimum of five entries for prize money to be awarded in Mini Prix.
