- ❖ A current NEGATIVE Coggins is required for all equines on VRSVA Property.
- ❖ In extreme heat, jackets may be excused at the discretion of the Judge.
- ❖ Judge's decision is final. NO TALKING TO THE JUDGE DURING THE SHOW.
- ❖ VHSA/BHSA rules apply to all VHSA/BHSA classes.
- ❖ All ages are as of December 1, 2026
- ❖ \$50 fee for all returned checks.
- ❖ We reserve the right to combine, cancel, split etc any classes.
- ❖ VRSVA owners, staff and volunteers will NOT be held responsible for injury or loss to equines, people, or property which may occur to any exhibitor, spectator, groom, or animal at the show
- ❖ Points will be counted according to VHSA/BHSA point system
- ❖ Exhibitors show at their own risk.
- ❖ Please do not allow unattended children in VRSVA barn.

Directions:

From 64: Take I64 to Rt. 15 towards Zion Crossroads exit. Follow 15 through Gordonsville circle about 3 miles. VRSVA is on the right.

From Fredericksburg: Take Rt. 3 to Rt. 20 West. Follow Rt. 20 west to the town of Orange. Turn Left onto Rt.15. Take the U-turn after passing VRSVA.

From Culpeper: Take Rt.15 south through the town Orange. Continue on Rt.15 for about 6 miles. Take the U-turn after passing VRSVA.

California Warm up- Not Judged. Each rider/horse combination may participate in 1 warm-up class per show. Rider MUST let the end gate know prior to entering the ring. Rider may ride any course with a time limit of 90 SECONDS.

Green Division: Test will consist of 10 of crossrails & verticals. Flower boxes may be added.

Starter Division: Jump test will consist of 10 jumps of verticals, oxers, planks, & fillers not to exceed 2'3".

Crossrail jumpers: Open to horses and ponies. No cross entries with classes 9-18 including riders.

Puddle Jumpers: Open to horses and Ponies. No cross entry with classes 15-18 including riders

Novice Children's/ Adult Amateur Jumper: Open horses and ponies ridden by Children and Adult Amateurs in their first or second year of showing in Jumper classes at 2'6" or higher as of December 1st of the current show year. Riders in this division may only cross-enter into Novice Jumper, if mount is eligible, TB Jumper and Low Jumper, and any other class not exceeding 3'. Fences shall be no lower than 2'3" and no higher than 2'6", with spreads no less than 2'3" and no greater than 2'6".

Novice Jumpers: Open to horses and ponies in their 1st or 2nd year of showing as jumpers at 2'6" or higher as of 12/1/25 no cross entry with classes 15-18

USEF Tables

Table II, Section 1

- Also known as a speed round, this class has one round where riders compete to go fast and clear.
- There is no jump-off, so riders must aim to go fast in the first round.
- Faults have the same effect in this round.

Table IV, Section 1

- The first round is decided by adding up faults and time penalties for exceeding the time allowed.
- If there is a tie for first place, the horse with the time closest to the "Optimum Time" wins.
- The Optimum Time is four seconds less than the Time Allowed.

Table II, Section 2 (b)

- Riders complete the first round
- Riders who complete the first round without faults wait for a buzzer
- Riders begin the jump-off course.
- The fastest clear rider in the jump-off wins.
