Rules: We follow both VHSA and BHSA Rules with VHSA Associate rules taking precedence.

COGGINS TEST: All exhibitors must present a negative Coggins Test report taken within one year on each animal exhibited. This is a Virginia State Law. Please bring an extra copy to leave with your entry if not uploaded with your entry.

SCHOOLING: Will be permitted only in designated schooling areas from 7:00-8:15am. Schooling is permitted in the indoor arena and out in the field all day long. There are also multiple schooling breaks throughout the show day.

ATTIRE: All exhibitors must wear ASTM/SEI protective helmets with harness fastened at all times while mounted on the show grounds.

AWARDS: The judge's decisions are always final. Six ribbons per class. Champion and Reserve Champion Ribbon awarded in each division.

Parking: There are two gates that allow entry or exit into a huge field for trailers and cars. Look for the Trailer Parking Sign as you come to the stop sign after Railroad Tracks. Parking is behind the riding/Show ring.. We ask that all cars also park out in the field to not block trailers trying to get in or out.

Class Descriptions:

California Warm-up: unjudged, only one trip per horse/rider combination.

Leadline: Open to riders 7 years and younger as of Dec. 1 of the current show year. Riders will be led and are not allowed to cross enter into any trot classes. Judged 50% equitation and 50% suitability.

* BHSA points for 1st class only, GRHSA division*

Pre-Short Stirrup Equitation: Open to riders 10 years and under as of Dec. 1 of the current show year. Riders may not cross enter into canter or jumping classes. *BHSA, GRHSA Division "

Short Stirrup Hunter : Open to riders 12 years and under as of Dec. 1 of the current show year. Riders may not cross enter into classes with jumps higher than 18". Courses may be trotted, and will be 4 fences.

VHSA, GRHSA Division

Novice Equitation: Open to Junior and Adult riders in their 1st or 2nd year of showing 18' or 2ft as of Dec. 1st of current show year.

Adults can ride ponies! Courses may be trotted and will be 4 fences. Short Stirrup must jump 18" *GRHSA pointed Division only"

Pleasure: Judged on manners, suitability, soundness and way of going. Ponies must be ridden by Juniors. Adults and Juniors will be combined if there are not enough entries. *BHSA, VHSA, GRHSA Division *

VHSA Equitation on the Flat: Open to Juniors and Adult Amateurs. Will be split into Juniors 14 and under, Juniors 15-17, and Adult Amateur if enough entries. *VHSA, BHSA, GRHSA Division *

Low Hunter: Open to horses and ponies. No restrictions on riders, minimum jump height is 2ft not to exceed 2'3" Will jump 6-8 fences. *BHSA, GRHSA pointed Division*

Green Hunter: Open to Horses in their 1st or 2nd year of showing over fences 2'6" or higher. Ponies in their 1st and 2nd year of showing at 2', 2'3", 2'6" or higher as of Dec. 1st of current show season. Entries Will be split if entries warrant, IF SPLIT GREEN PONY WILL GO after PONY HUNTER. . *VHSA, BHSA, GRHSA Division"

Pony Equitation: Open to Juniors on ponies. Jump heights: Small 2'; Medium 2'3"; Large 2'6". *VHSA, BHSA, GRHSA Division"

VHSA/EMO PONY EQUITATION ON THE FLAT: Open to junior riders on ponies who are current members of VHSA. *VHSA division only

VHSA/EMO Junior Championship Equitation on the flat class.

Open to Junior Members of the VHSA.-Riders must-show all working gaits in both directions as well as lengthening of stride at all working gaits in each direction.-Sitting trot should be a working sitting trot.-Counter canter in both directions is required. May be combined with VHSA/EMO Adult Amateur Equitation on the flat.*VHSA division only

VHSA/EMO Amateur Equitation on the flat class: Open to Adult Amateur VHSA members on horses. *VHSA division only

Pony Hunter: Open to Ponies 14.2 hands & under ridden by juniors. Jumps: Small 2FT, Medium 2'3"; Large 2'6". If entries are enough small/medium will be combined and large ponies will be run separately. *VHSA, BHSA, GRHSA Division*

Children's/Adult Equitation: Open to Juniors or Adult Amateurs mounted on horses. Minimum Jump height is 2'6". *VHSA, BHSA, GRHSA Division"

Children's/Adult Amateur Hunter: Open to Horses ridden by Juniors or Adult Amateurs. Will be split if there are enough entries. Minimum Jump height is 2'6" * Points for VHSA, BHSA, and GRHSA Division

Thoroughbred Hunter: Open to registered TBs and horses eligible to be registered. No restriction on riders, minimum jump height 2'6". Can be combined with Green Hunter and Open Working Hunter. *VHSA, GRHSA, BHSA Division*

Child/Adult Special Hunter: Open to Horses and Ponies; Adults may ride ponies that have not been entered Into a Pony division. Jump height is available at 18", 2ft, or 2'3" GRHSA Division only *

Open Working Hunter: Open to all Horses. Minimum Jump height is 2'9". *VHSA, BHSA, GRHSA Division*

Baby Green: Open to all horses or ponies in their 1st or 2nd year of showing. No rider restrictions, adults may ride ponies. Jump height 18" or 2ft, will jump 4 fences. *GRHSA pointed Division only
